Giving Back to the Community

For the last 15 years Cantores Celestes has donated over \$40,000 to more than 35 charities, helping men, women and children in the Toronto area and beyond. For our Christmas concert this year, we are donating the \$1,000 to Put Up Your Dukes.

Put Up Your Dukes was created in November of 2011, co-founded by Bobbi & Harv Lewin in memory of their son Ryan "Duke" Lewin, who committed suicide after battling mental illness and addiction. Their goal remains to shed light on the suffering associated with mental illness by creating a fundraiser to support CAMH. Their goal of their first fundraiser was to raise funds to build Duke's Place, a new lounge for young people located in the Intergenerational Wellness Centre at CAMH, Canada's first dedicated centre to provide in-patient care for adolescents aged 14 to 18 suffering with concurrent disorders (both mental illness and addictions).

This year they are raising funds for The Lewin Family Living Learning Room, where where patients can eat together as well as engage in conversation in a pleasant environment. The facility will also serve as a meeting space for patients to learn daily life skills, engage in crafts, games, and team meetings as well as provide a welcoming, sun-filled space for family visits.
