- 1. - 2. Yes!!

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #9

- 1. God
- 2. Peace = "shalom" = "good health, safety, prosperity, perfect peace, be well" H7965 in the Strong's Concordance. This shows the original meaning and definition of all the words in the Bible.
- 3. We shall be far from oppression, for we shall not fear; and far from terror, for it shall not come near us.
- 4. If anyone stirs up strife, it is not from God; whoever stirs up strife with us shall fall because of us.
- 5. "No weapon that is fashioned against us shall succeed, and we shall refute every tongue that rises against us in judgment. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and their vindication from me, declares the Lord."

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #10

- 1. "This is like the days of Noah to me: as I swore that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so I have sworn that I will not be angry with you, and I will not rebuke you."
