# **JUNETEENTH PARADE 2024 GUIDLINES**

- Check-in starts at 8:00 a.m. at Jones School Complex to decorate vehicles and line up
   Only parade participants and entries are to be at this location.
- The parade begins promptly at 10 a.m..
- Route is from Jones School Complex to San Jacinto Fairgrounds.
- All entries must be decorated and all walkers must be specially dressed up
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages are allowed, and participants may not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Weapons, firearms and/or explosives, including firecrackers
- Throwing candy or objects to onlookers, string & confetti are not allowed
- All entrants must maintain the pace of the parade there will be no stops
- No vehicle swerving while in motion is allowed
- All drivers must possess a driver's license and liability insurance.
- Drivers must have 180-degree and forward vision
- All entries must reflect good taste, appropriate dress, and behavior (no profanity).
- A list of all participants must be provided and each participant must sign the following waiver prior to the parade.

A sheet will be provided to sign by all participants prior to the parade.

PLEASE NOTE: THE JONES SCHOOL LOCATION CAN NOT BE USED AS A CONGREGATING LOCATION AND IS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF PREPARING PARADE ENTRIES.

NOTE: THE PARADE ENTRIES WILL BE SECURE FROM 8:45 UNTIL 9:30 AS PARADE PARTICIPANTS ARE URGED TO PLEASE ATTEND THE JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION KICKOFF THAT BEGINS AT 9:00 A.M. WITH THE JUNETEENTH FLAG-RAISING CEREMONY OVER SAN JACINTO COUNTY AND THE EMANCIPATION PROGRAM ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE COURTHOUSE SQUARE. (THIS IS A VERY SOLEMN AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORICAL OCCASION. ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS ARE ASKED TO PLEASE SHOW THEIR SUPPORT BY ATTENDING).
