RULES

Outfits must be made from recyclable or reused materials.* Entries may be made by an individual or by a group. However, there will only be one prize awarded to the top pick from each category.

ENTRIES

Participants will enter one of four (4) categories. One winner will be chosen from each of these categories. All participants will then be entered into age categories, based on the age of the designer, for a chance to win one of three (3) overall prizes for each age group.

DAY OF THE EVENT

Each participant will be asked to complete a registration card which will list the designer's name, model name (if different) and items used in making the outfit. Models will be asked to sign a photo release form which will require parental consent if the participant is under 18 years of age. **Photo release forms are available in advance at www.wvrecycles.com.**

AGE CATEGORIES

Participants will be divided into age groups. 13 & Under and 14 & Over based on the age of the designer.

THEMED CATEGORIES

Participants may enter in one of the following categories:

Coca-Cola® Challenge: Outfit must be made using Coca-Cola® brand products which includes Dasani water. The use of any Coca-Cola® product must be noticeable.

Charleston Town Center Challenge: Outfit must be made utilizing materials found in a bathroom (shower curtains, bathroom tissue, cardboard tubes, tissues, towels, etc.)

Charleston Newspaper Challenge: Majority of outfit must be made from newspapers.

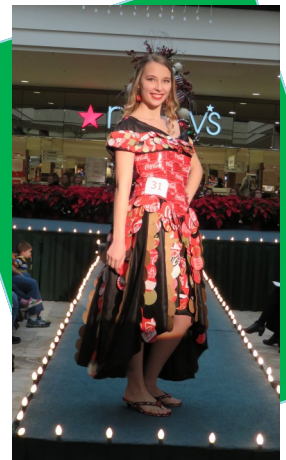
General Theme: Anything goes, in this category! Any other non-specific themed item will
