

Facebook Message Warning - 2.23.13

In the last two days, I have received three bogus emails supposedly from Facebook Admin. Below are samples of what they look like:

DO NOT OPEN THEM. If you look at them carefully, you will notice that the email address (while it says Technical Support or Support Services Manager) is bogus. I opened one up on my iPad by mistake at first and luckily it did nothing. I did not open it on my computer and intend not to.

Please be aware of any message from ANY COMPANY that you transact with. Please check the underlying email address and if you are still not sure, erase it, log into their website separately, give them a call, email the customer service email address on their website re recent inquiry OR forward the bogus message to them. **DO NOT OPEN.**
