

Competition Format

Report to the control desk for each round. The second team to check in will receive the match sheet and must locate the team that checked in already. The winning team will return the sheet to the control desk.

Team matches end when one team wins 5 matches. If the score is 4-2 play both the 7th and 8th matches at the same time. Do not wait and play single matches at the end. The 8th match will not count if the score is 5-2.

There are no scheduled meal breaks. You should manage your meals when you have a break, such as when your teammates are playing.

Stage One: At 9:00 AM on Saturday, teams will play one contest to determine which division they will play in. Some teams will have a bye, the other teams will play a single contest.

Stage Two: After all preliminary matches are finished, team captains will pick up division schedules. An announcement will be made when schedules are ready. Round One following the preliminary round could have a slight delay if matches run long. Teams will play against every team in their division. There are 6 divisions. There are 7 teams in the first division and 8 teams in divisions 2-6. Each team in Division One will have a bye round. Team captains' meeting on Saturday at 8:45 am at Table One. Those teams with byes for the preliminary round will have the captains' meeting at 10 am. A contest may start early, if the tables are available and both teams agree.
