set win at Alabama last Saturday. Burrow is completing 79% of this passes this year with 33 TD's and just 4 INT's!

Auburn (+4.8 ppg), Tulane (+4.2 ppg) and Appalachian St (+3.9 ppg) are all 7-2 ATS this season. Meanwhile, Arizona (-7.5 ppg), Rutgers (-6.5 ppg), Michigan St (-6.2 ppg), Northwestern (-5.5 ppg) and Ohio (-3.3 ppg) are all 2-7 ATS.

SMU games (+13.2 ppg) are 9-1 to the OVER while Boston College (+6.4 ppg) and Central Michigan (+5.2) are 8-2 to the OVER. San Diego St games (-9.4 ppg) are 8-1 to the UNDER while Missouri (-9.9 ppg), Georgia (-9.1 ppg), Pittsburgh (-8.6 ppg), California (-6.4 ppg) and Bowling Green (-6.2 ppg) are all 7-2 to the UNDER.

Misleading Finals

West Virginia lost to Texas Tech 38-17 but the Mountaineers had a 549-481 yard edge but were done in by a -4 TO margin. West Virginia was also stopped on downs 3 different times inside Texas Tech's 25-yard line!

Texas had a 477-304 yard edge vs Kansas State but only won by 3 thanks to a key 98-yard kick return TD by Kansas St in the second half.

Penn St was +58 yards vs Minnesota last week but the Nittany Lions had 3 interceptions and were stopped on downs inside Minnesota's 10-yard line.

South Carolina had 22-11 first down and 346-202 yard edges vs Appalachian St but somehow lost the game outright. The key play was a interception return TD for App St late in the second quarter that gave them momentum.

Bad Beats

They don't call it "UNDER TIME" for a reason. If you had UNDER 48.5 in the Baylor/TCU game, we feel your pain. Clearly, you had the right side as the two teams had combined for just 18 points after regulation. Remarkably, neither team scored a single TD in the first 60 minutes. However, the teams exchanged TD's in the first overtime and also both scored TD's in the second OT. Baylor ended up winning 29-23 and TCU (+2.5 or +3) backers also had a bad beat as the Horned Frogs had covered all 60 minutes of regulation.

If you had **UNDER 63.5** in the Florida State-Boston College game, we also feel your pain. BC tied it up at 24-24 with 2:33 to go. FSU answered with a 60-yard TD to re-take the lead, 31-24 with 1:48 left. FSU then got an interception and instead of running out the clock with a first down, the Noles got another long TD with 1:03 to go. Finally, BC went 75 yards in 4 plays and got a touchdown with just 14 seconds left to put game OVER. Keep in mind, in the first 57-plus minutes of the game, there were just 41 points. In the final 2:33, the teams got 28. Dadgummit!

Louisville QB Micale Cunningham is questionable vs NC State Missouri QB Kelly Bryant (hamstring) is questionable vs Florida.

Notre Dame DL Julian Okwara (leg) is out for the season. Texas Tech QB Alan Bowman (redshirt) is out for the season

Toledo RB Bryant Koback (leg) is questionable vs Northern Illinois.

Toledo QB's Carter Bradley and Mitchell Guadagni are both questionable. UAB QB Tyler Johnston (knee) has been downgraded to out vs UTEP.

Vanderbilt QB's Riley Neal (concussion) is questionable vs Kentucky.

Games in Rotation Order Wednesday, November 13th HOME TEAM IN CAPS

MIAMI, OH 35 Bowling Green 16. In the last 4 years, Miami, Oh has often times struggled in non-conference action going just 2-15 SU/5-12 ATS but once MACtion heats up, the Red Hawks are 20-9 SU/19-9-1 ATS in league play. This year has been no different as after starting 0-4 ATS in non-conference action, they've covered 4 of 5 vs conference opponents. We lean with Miami here.

TOLEDO 29 Northern Illinois 25. Obviously the big question here is that Toledo RB Bryant Koback (leg) and QB's Carter Bradley and Mitchell Guadagni are all questionable. QB Eli Peters will probably start and does have experience dating back to last year when he started 11 games. Toledo would like to rely on their run game which averages 250 ypg (best in the MAC). We have a slight lean on the Rockets.

Thursday, November 14th

Buffalo 28 KENT ST 26. Our power ratings are strong on Kent State here but we do think they are at a match-up disadvantage at the line of scrimmage. The Golden Flashes defense allows 255 rush ypg while Buffalo's rush offense averages 224 rush ypg. The Bulls have been playing their best football of the season as of late with 4 straight covers but we feel that comes to an end here.

PITTSBURGH 27 North Carolina 22. Remarkably, 8 of North Carolina's 9 games this season have been decided by 7 points or less and the Tar Heels are 3-5 in those games. They did get a much-needed by elast week. NC does need to win 2 of their last 3 games to get to bowl eligibility. On the other side, Pitt is already bowl eligible as the Panthers have relied on a defense that is allowing only 86 rush ypg and has 40 sacks on the season. We expect another close NC game here.

<u>Friday, November 15th</u>

MARSHALL 28 Louisiana Tech 27. Louisiana Tech is quietly having a stellar season. The Bulldogs have won 8 straight games since losing to Texas in the opener and they've covered 4 straight. The offense is really starting to gel averaging 52 ppg in their last 4. Meanwhile, Marshall has relied a little more on their defense. While LT has control of the West division, Marshall needs a win here to keep pace with FAU in the East. Slight lean on LT here.

SAN DIEGO ST 22 Fresno St 20. The Aztecs are coming off a big upset loss at home to Nevada last week (the Aztecs were -17) as they allowed just 226 yards on defense, but again couldn't muster up enough offense. A win here and a win at Hawaii next week would still lock up the division for them. San Diego St games are 8-1 to the UNDER this year as they're only averaging 35 total ppg. Meanwhile, Fresno St was also upset last week at home losing 37-35 (-5.5) to Utah St and now need to win 2 of their last 3 to get to bowl eligibility. The Bulldogs defense has allowed 500 or more yards in 3 straight games. We don't agree with Fresno being favored here.

Saturday, November 16th

KANSAS ST 32 West Virginia 18. Kansas St comes in off a misleading loss to Texas where they were out-gained 477-304 but only lost by 3. West Virginia also had a misleading loss to Texas Tech where they out-gained Texas Tech 549-481 but were done in by 4 TO's and were also stopped on downs 3 times inside Tech's 25-yard line. The Mountaineers have struggled running the ball only managing 76 ypg. Still, those two misleading results from last week have us backing off K-State here. We do lean OVER. Virginia Tech 28 GEORGIA TECH 23. Virginia Tech is playing their best ball of the season as they've won 4 of their last 5 games. After nearly upsetting ND two weeks ago, they did pull the upset over Wake Forest last week crushing the Demon Deacons 36-17. Georgia Tech has also been far more competitive as of late and last week only fell at Virginia by 5. Our power ratings are right near the number here.

Tulane 29 TEMPLE 27. We disagree with the early money on Tulane here. Yes, they're coming off a bye and their offense is averaging 36 ppg and 261 rush ypg. However, Temple also has a couple extra days to prep after last Thursday's win over USF. We think there's been an overreaction to their blowout losses to SMU and UCF in their previous two games. The Owls have already pulled outright upsets over Maryland and Memphis this year and could pull another one here.

PENN ST 33 Indiana 20. Indiana is ranked for the first time since 1994 and the Hoosiers come in off a bye. However, QB Michael Pennix is out for season but there's only a 0.5-point downgrade in our opinion to Peyton Ramsey, who has a ton of experience. Note the favorite in Indiana games

under head coach Tom Allen is 30-3 SU/19-12-2 ATS. Meanwhile, Penn St was +58 yards vs Minnesota last week but had 3 interceptions and were stopped on downs inside Minnesota's 10-yard line. Penn St head coach James Franklin after a SU loss is only 3-12-3 ATS (-5 ppg). Lean Indy.

Cincinnati 32 SOUTH FLORIDA 20. We thought we would be liking Cincinnati here but the line is just way too steep. Last week the Bearcats defense rebounded after their worst performance of the season vs ECU (allowed 43 points and 638 yards) as they held UConn to just 3 points and 218 yards. Meanwhile, USF is into the meat of their conference schedule (Memphis and UCF on deck) and it looks like the Bulls will miss out on a bowl. We're passing here.

2★ Syracuse (plus the points) DUKE 31 Syracuse 24. We think there's value on the Cuse here as who in the world wants to bet on a team that has failed to cover 5 straight games? We do. Last week, we had an embarrass-

ing loser on these pages with Duke as they were crushed at home by Notre Dame 38-7. It Pending Bets Pending Bet was their worst performance of the season on offense as they only managed 197 total yards. Meanwhile, Syracuse comes in off a bye. In their last game, the Orange allowed 691 yards and a program-record 496 rush yards to BC that led to the firing of their D.C. Brian Ward. We think they'll have a much



Ohio St 58 RUTGERS 6. This is the largest away favorite role for any team in college football since 1987 (Oklahoma at the Kansas schools). It is deserved considering the Buckeyes have remarkably covered 8 games in a row and Ohio St is No. 1 in ATS margin (+17.2 ppg), No. 1 in ypg differential (+321 ypg) and No. 1 in PATS InlagIn (+12.2 ppg), No. 1 in Ppg differential (+42.4 ppg). On the other side, Rutgers is No. 127 in ypg differential (-151 ypg) and No. 127 in ppg differential (-22 ppg). We lean OVER. **Louisville 30 NC STATE 28.** NC State has really disappointed this season

as the Wolf Pack have covered just 2 games this season and have a -9.9 ppg ATS margin this year (3rd worst in the country). NC State has been outscored 99-20 in their last 2 games alone. On the other side, Louisville has been a pleasant surprise under first-year head coach Scott Satterfield and the Cardinals need just one win for bowl eligibility. Still, this line looks a bit steep here being above a FG.

2★ IOWA 26 Minnesota 20. Both teams have played in a bunch of coin flip games this year but there's a great disparity in the two teams' records in those games. Iowa is 1-3 in games decided by 7 points or less. Meanwhile, Minnesota is 5-0 in games decided by 7 points or less including last week when they were -58 yards vs Penn St but were +2 in TO's. In our opinion, that gives us value on the Hawkeyes. Also how will Minnesota handle success off their biggest win in 50-plus years? Finally, Iowa has played the much tougher schedule so far (No. 26 vs No. 70).

CLEMSON 48 Wake Forest 14. Clemson is now on a 17-0 SU (+34.7 ppg) and 15-2 ATS (+9.2 ppg) run vs ACC opponents. Remember, Clemson is just two FG's away from 9-1 ATS this season but the game everyone wants to talk about is the North Carolina game. To us, the Tigers look extremely motivated since that North Carolina near upset as the Tigers have outscored their opponents 263-55 (53-11 average score). QB Trevor Lawrence is back up to No. 7 in QBR. Meanwhile, Wake is reeling a bit after a blowout loss to Virginia Tech and yesterday news broke that their star WR Sage Surratt is out for the season. We lean OVER.

BALL ST 31 Central Michigan 28. While Ball St has got their run game going as of late (292 rush ypg in their last 3), their run defense has allowed 316 and 382 yards in back-to-back losses to Ohio and Western Michigan. Now, they take on a Central Michigan offense that is averaging 38 ppg in their last 5 games. Our power ratings are strong on Ball St here but we're only leaning with the Cardinals.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN 35 UL-Monroe 27. ULM did pull the upset over Georgia St last week but the WarHawks still allowed 414 rushing yards and benefited from Georgia St's QB Dan Ellington getting hurt in the first half. Now that poor ULM rush D (allowing 255 ypg on the season) takes on the Georgia Southern option attack that is averaging 257 rush ypg. We lean with the home team and the OVER here.

NORTHWESTERN 46 Massachusetts 6. It sounds like a broken record at this point but UMass is the worst team we've ever power-rated. They are -278 ypg and are getting out-scored by 32 ppg. The Minutemen are -3.5 in yards per play differential and are 1-9 ATS on the season. However, Northwestern is in their biggest favorite role in school history here as they are 40.5-point favorites. Keep in mind, the Wildcats have only scored 38 points in their last 5 games combined! Lean UNDER.

Troy 33 TEXAS ST 25. Troy comes in off a 49-28 win over Georgia Southern that kept their faint bowl hopes alive (league powers ULL and App St are on deck). Their offense is averaging 36 ppg and 479 ypg. Meanwhile, Texas St got a 30-28 win over South Alabama last week but the Bobcats have failed to cover the spread in 4 straight games. We don't see a lot of value in this one.

BOISE ST 43 New Mexico 16. Obviously, Boise St disappointed us greatly on these pages last week as despite facing a backup QB in Wyoming, the Broncos needed OT to survive. Boise's QB Hank Bachmeier was expected to play, but remained on the sidelines due to an undisclosed injury he suffered against San Jose State last week. We weren't alone in backing Boise as we gave them out at -13 and they closed as 16-point favorites. On the other side, this looks like the final season for New Mexico head coach Bob Davie as the Lobos are 2-7 SU/ATS but are coming off a bye. We pass.

UTAH 37 Ucla 17. Both teams are off a bye and peaking. Utah has 5 straight covers but misleading win over Washington in their last game as a "Pick 6" late in the 3Q changed momentum. On the other side, UCLA is 5-1 ATS in their last 6 after their atrocious start and at 4-5 overall are thinking possible bowl game. Remarkably, if UCLA were to win this game, they'd be in first place in the Pac-12 South. Their new found run game averaging 231 ypg will be up against it here vs a Utah rush defense allowing only 56 ypg. Still a slight lean on UCLA.

Air Force 34 COLORADO ST 25. Colorado St is playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight wins and covers and now are thinking possible bowl. Their run defense has shown improvement in recent weeks but is still allowing 204 ypg and will be up against it here vs an Air Force rushing attack that is averaging 324 rush ypg. Still, this line is a bit steep for a rivalry game and we're leaning with the home dog.

UTAH ST 29 Wyoming 22. Obviously, Wyoming beat us last week on these pages in their near upset of Boise St. They had done well at the line of scrimmage all season (98 rush ypg allowed) and the Cowboys only allowed 91 rush yards to the Broncos. Meanwhile, Utah St played their best game since early in the season as the Aggies got an upset win at Fresno St and now can breathe a little easier when it comes to a bowl bid. Don't see much value here. Pass.

Appalachian St 37 GEORGIA ST 21. Last week we lost on these pages going against Appalachian St as they were out-gained 346-202 and out-FD'd 22-11 but won outright over South Carolina. Again, Meanwhile, Georgia St lost their fine QB Dan Ellington in the first half vs ULM last week and their offense stalled in the second half of an upset loss. Ellington won't play here (we think he's worth around 4 points) and therefore we can't recommend a Georgia St team that has already pulled 3 outright upsets this season.

NOTRE DAME 33 Navy 21. There is a ton of money in the market place on Navy in this game and we don't necessarily agree with it. Notre Dame has played the much tougher schedule (No. 31 vs No. 97). Navy has played one Top 40 team (at Memphis) and they lost that game by 12. Navy is in the Top 12 in terms of ypg differential (+146.2) ppg differential (+22) and ypp differential (+2.0) and the Midshipmen are 12-2 ATS (+6.4 ppg) in their last 14 visits to South Bend. Still all of that is being priced into the line and then some with this very short line. We like the Irish who impressed us last week on these pages as they dominated our Duke pick.

Arizona St 29 OREGON ST 28. Jayden Daniels will play here for Arizona St, hence why the Sun Devils have gone to a 3-point favorite. Last week they nearly rallied to beat USC but were still out-gained by 208 yards. They have lost 3 straight and need a win. On the other side, Oregon St was beat worse than the 19-7 final vs Washington last week as the Beavers were out-gained 420-119. They now need to win 2 of their last 3 to qualify for a bowl. Slight lean on the home team here.

Usc 27 CALIFORNIA 23. USC is on a 14-1 SU/10-5 ATS run vs California but last year the Bears did break that long losing streak winning 15-14 in L.A. USC head coach Clay Helton gets a lot of heat and deservedly so. However, if USC wins out, they'll finish 8-4 playing a backup QB all season and the Trojans season win total was only 6.5! Last week the Trojans got by an Arizona St team that was playing a backup QB. USC was more dominant than the final indicated as they were +208 yards. On the other side, California broke their 4-game losing streak with a 33-20 win over Washington St. 2nd string QB Devon Modster returned from injury after Cal had to use a 3rd string QB vs Utah. Modster was 16 of 24 for 230 yards and 3 TD's. We lean with Cal here.

OREGON 47 Arizona 23. Both teams off a bye and this is a revenge spot for Oregon as they lost 44-15 (-9.5) to Arizona last year. However, we feel this is too many points to lay vs Arizona's No. 12 offense (averaging 496 ypg). The Oregon defense has been exposed a bit allowing 405 ypg and 30 ppg in their last 3. We do wonder if Oregon had beat Auburn in the opener (led the entire game), they probably would be sitting at No. 3 in the polls. While we lean with Arizona here, they did fire their DC and then proceeded to allow 56 points to Oregon St. We're not sure it gets a lot better here.

ARKANSAS ST 37 Coastal Carolina 26. Arkansas St comes in fresh off a bye and the Red Wolves need just one win to get to bowl eligibility. Meanwhile, Coastal comes in losers of 4 of their last 5 games as they were run over by UL-Lafayette last week. However, we're actually leaning with the dog here as statistically they are the better team with better marks in ppg differential, ypg differential and yards per play differential.

UAB 31 Utep 13. UAB is 16-0 SU (+19.3 ppg) and 13-2-1 ATS (+6.2 ppg) at home the last 3 years but the Blazers will be playing without QB Tyler Johnston here who also missed last week's game vs Southern Miss as UAB managed only 173 yards and 2 points. Dylan Hopkins was 15 of 25 for 103 yards and 2 INT's. On the other side, UTEP blew a 21-7 lead vs Charlotte. That's now 8 straight losses since their season-opening win. We don't see much value here.

TEXAS A&M 32 South Carolina 20. An interesting trend for Texas A&M here as the Aggies are on a 0-13-1 ATS (-9.7 ppg) run off a regular season by since 2008. Obviously, head coach Jimbo Fisher has only been here for one of those losses. On the other side, we lost on these pages with South Carolina last week as their bowl hopes are pretty much dashed after losing to Appalachian St. The Gamecocks had 22-11 first down and 346-202 yard edges but lost outright. Don't see much value here.

3★ AUBURN 21 Georgia 20. Auburn has played the tougher schedule (No. 2 vs No. 52) and the Tigers are off a bye. Auburn is also off a misleading 6-point win vs Ole Miss III Verizon ? 8:01 AM (26-16 first down and 507- **≺** Pending Bets Pending Bet 266 yard edge) as they missed 3 FG's. Meanwhile, Georgia's offense has only averaged 22 STRAIGHT BET Risk: \$575.00 To Win: \$500.00 ppg the last 4 games and now face best defense they've seen Nov-16 NCAA FOOTBALL all year. While their defense [372] AUBURN +3-115 has notably shut out two of their last 3 opponents, note is not necessarily the same as the status at the time of the transaction. that one came vs a Kentucky team down to a 3rd string QB in the pouring rain and then last week vs another backup QB in Missouri. On the other side, Auburn true frosh QB Bo Nix has been better home at home this year (60% com-

UL-Lafayette 37 SOUTH ALABAMA 13. We've upgraded UL-Lafayette as much as any team in college football this year (along with Navy). The Ragin Cajuns are 8-1 ATS with an average cover of 11.5 ppg. They're in the Top 12 of ppg differential, ypg differential and yards per play differential but this is their largest away favorite role in school history. On the other side, South Alabama has covered 4 of their last 5 games and is

getting a little too disrespected in the market here. Lean on the dog. OKLAHOMA ST 41 Kansas 24. Both teams come in off a bye. A couple weeks ago we took a chance with Kansas on these pages and they got crushed vs rival Kansas St. Did teams finally get enough tape on new O.C. Brent Dearmon's offense? On the other side, we just need a win here for Oklahoma St to cash a season win total bet. The Pokes are 7-2 ATS this season (of course one of those ATS losers was when we backed them on these pages). Their RB Chuba Hubbard leads the nation in rushing with 1,604 yards but they did lose their top WR Tyan Wallace to injury for the season. We don't see much value here.

2★ Texas (plus the points) IOWA ST 34 Texas 31. Why is Iowa St laying 7 here? Quite simply, the analytics guys love them. The Cyclones are No. 16 in yards per play differential (+1.7) while Texas is No. 81 (-0.1). However, Texas is off a misleading last second win vs Kansas St last week. The Horns had 24-17 first down and 477-304 yard edges but did allow a 98-yard kick return TD. Obviously, we have the Tom Herman as an underdog trends with him being 14-4 ATS as a head coach. Meanwhile, Iowa St is off emotional near win at Oklahoma where they come up just short. The Cyclones have lost 4 games by a combined 11 points this year. Note that while Matt Campbell is great in the Big 12 (69% ATS), he's not been good vs Texas (0-3 ATS -6.7 ppg) and he's only managed 23 combined points on offense. Finally, Iowa St has met Texas 15 times since 1980 and the Cyclones have never been favored over the Longhorns (avg line +12.2). Is this an historically great Iowa St team? Maybe, maybe not. Is this a historically poor Texas team? No. So why do we have a historic line here again?

Tcu 30 TEXAS TECH 27. TCU is off a bad beat game where they had covered all 60 minutes of regulation (+2.5 or +3) only to see Baylor win in 3 OT's and get the cover. On top of that the total was a bad beat (see page 1). On the other side, Texas Tech crushed West Virginia last week but the Red Raiders were +4 in TO's and also stopped West Virginia 3 times inside the 25-yard line while the Mountaineers were in scoring territory. Those misleading results give you great reasons why TCU is laying a FG on the road here.

Oklahoma 37 BAYLOR 28. Honestly, we'd like to play against both teams. Oklahoma is No. 1 in country in yards per play differential (+4.0) but Baylor is No. 10 (+2.1). The Oklahoma defense has struggled the last couple of games allowing 40-plus points to Kansas St and Iowa St. In our opiniion, they're not playing complimentary football (offense/defense) as their RB's have a total of 42 carries total in the last 3 games and the OU defense has been on the field too much. On the other side, Baylor has won 4 games by 6 points or less including one in 2OT and one in 3OT...they never led vs TCU last week until OT. We're passing for now.

Memphis 38 HOUSTON 28. Both teams come in off a bye. Despite redshirting their all-everything QB, Houston doesn't look like they have given up on the season as they nearly pulled an outright upset over SMU and then fared well at UCF in their last two games (both covers). Meanwhile, Memphis now has an inside track to getting a major bowl berth after their win over SMU two weeks ago. Keep in mind, Memphis does host Cincinnati late in the year (Tigers will be short favorites) and the two teams could play each other the very next week in the AAC Championship game. As far as this game goes, we don't see too much value.

Kentucky 26 VANDERBILT 17. We get it, Vanderbilt is terrible and the Commodores are 1-8 ATS this season failing to cover by 8 ppg. Will Derek Mason still have a job in Nashville come next season? That's a legit question at this point. However, do you really want to lay doubles on the road with Kentucky's struggling offense that has only averaged 15 ppg in their last 7 games? We sure don't. Lean Vanderbilt.

MICHIGAN 31 Michigan St 14. Michigan comes in off a bye and is taking on a MSU team that seems like a broken program at this point with off-field issues/scandals and their best defensive player Joe Bachie being busted for PED's. Sparty blew a 25-point lead last week vs Illinois and that's now 5 straight non-covers for them. Yes, Michigan St has owned this series as of late as they are 8-3 SU/10-1 ATS (+10 ppg) but that one non-cover was last season. Note the school that finishes with the most rushing yards has won 44 of the last 49 meetings and MSU is only averaging 131 rush ypg this season.

Florida 27 MISSOURI 21. Missouri home/away splits this year are among the most disparate in the country. At home they are 5-0 SU (+28.8 ppg)/4-1 ATS (+9.7 ppg) but on the road 0-4 SU (-15.5 ppg) and 0-4 ATS (-22.4 ppg). Will Kelly Bryant play at QB for the Tigers and how effective will he be if he does play. If you're optimistic on him, then we feel you should take the points. If not, then lay it if you play it. We're sitting back. Hawaii 38 UNLV 31. UNLV is down to two final home games at Sam Boyd stadium as they will play in the new Raiders Stadium next season. The Rebels come in off a bye after a 20-point loss at Colorado St probably sealed the fate of head coach Tony Sanchez. Although we think if he were

to win his final three games, it'd be tough to fire him. Note that Hawaii does travel well here as they bring thousands of fans to Vegas. We lean UNDER here as the wind is supposed to be 15-plus mph on Saturday.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE 30 Rice 17. Both teams come in off a bye. MT needs to win out to get to bowl eligibility while Rice is still looking for their first win of the season. MT's rush defense has been their biggest weakness allowing 210 ypg but we're not sure a feeble Rice offense can take advantage. All those sharp bettors who had been betting the Owls week after week and losing seem to have disappeared from the market place as MT has taken the early money here.

Southern Miss 32 UTSA 16. UTSA has been undervalued in the market this season as they have covered 4 of their last 5 games and have pulled 3 outright upsets. With that being said, they're up against it here vs a Southern Miss defense that has allowed just 156 ypg and 4 ppg in their last 2. We lean UNDER.

3★ UNDER 61.5 Alabama 36 MISSISSIPPI ST 17. We love the UN-DER here. First, The UNDER is 10-1-1 in the series with an average cover of 10.2 ppg. Wisconsin 32 NEBRASKA 19. Nebraska is just 1-8 ATS this year failing to cover by 8.4 ppg. However, the Huskers are off a bye and QB Martinez should be healthier. Meanwhile, Wisconsin has been much more dominant at home (+257 ypg) than on the road (+47 ypg) this season. Lean on the home team who still has bowl aspirations.

Lsu 41 OLE MISS 21. Normally, we'd jump in head first on Ole Miss here catching LSU off that historic win over Alabama last week. The Rebels are a quiet 5-1 ATS vs SEC foes and are basically off a bye after taking care of New Mexico St last week. However, note that LSU head coach Ed Orgeron vs the Ole Miss team that fired him is 3-0 SU (+20.7 ppg) and 3-0 ATS (+11.7 ppg).

WASHINGTON ST 34 Stanford 26. Stanford was another miserable failure on these pages last week as the Cardinal were outright upset at Colorado. However, note that Stanford head coach David Shaw is 13-1 SU (+19 ppg) and 13-0-1 ATS (+9.4 ppg) off a straight up loss as a favorite. It might be a good spot considering Washington St has also been a huge disappointment this season as the Cougars are also coming off a road upset loss at California. Lean on the Cardinal.

Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 224-176-10 (56%) clip the last three years. That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Last week's plays went 3-2 and now the record for this year is 60-51-2. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 10 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be Auburn +3.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

They've been horrific on offense as they have failed to score a TD in three straight games for the first time in the 88-year history of the franchise. We like the Jets who got a confidence boosting win over their N.Y.C. rivals last week. The defense held NYG RB Barkley to just 1 yard on 13 carries and QB Darnold didn't throw a pick.

3★ Miami (plus the points) Buffalo 21 MIAMI 19. Do you want to lay 6 points on the road with a Bills offense that averages just 19 ppg? Also the Bills 6 wins have come against teams with a combined 12-44 record. Miami actually out-gained Buffalo by 76 yards in the earlier meeting and Buffalo got a misleading 10-point win. The Dolphins are not tanking this season. They're not an historically poor team. In fact, they're playing like a typical below-average team as of late but they have 5 straight covers! Buffalo weather this week...highs in the 20's and 30's. Miami weather this week in the low 80's and upper 70's.

BALTIMORE 26 Houston 24. The Texans come in off a bye while Baltimore basically had a bye last week taking on the hapless Cincinnati Bengals. Last week Lamar Jackson became only the 2nd player in NFL history to have 2 games in the same season with a perfect passer rating (Big Ben the other). Obviously, a lot of playoff implications in this game. Houston hasn't lost by more than 7 points in 2 years while Baltimore maybe sitting fat and happy with 5 straight wins. Harbaugh is not good in the favorite role hitting 43% the last 9 years (37-49-4). To the wire.

SAN FRANCISCO 29 Arizona 19. These two just played on Hallow-een night with Arizona getting the cover. Obviously, Kyler Murray and the Cardinals have impressed us so far this season (7-3 ATS). However, Murray did throw that back-breaking pick last week ending a streak of 211 passes without an INT. Now the Cardinals face a San Fran team off their first loss of the season. How much effort are the 49ers willing to put in here off that MNF war and the Packers on deck?

New England 26 PHILADELPHIA 19. Since the Patriots won their first Super Bowl back in 2001 and became a very public team the season after, head coach Bill Belichick off a straight up loss is still 40-21-2 ATS 66% (+5.6 ppg). Off a bye Belichick is 15-12-1 ATS 56% (+3.4 ppg). Belichick is also 48-27-2 ATS 64% (+5.2 ppg) with revenge (teams last played in Super Bowl). Do you really want to buck those trends? We don't.

OAKLAND 28 Cincinnati 17. When everyone was floating the word "tanking" earlier in the season it was all about the Miami Dolphins. However, now we know who really is the worst team in the NFL and that's the Bengals who arguably have the least qualified coaching staff in the NFL and now the least qualified QB in Ryan Finley. On the other side, the Raiders have impressed all year. Do note against better competition that they are 5-1 in one possession games this season.

2★ UNDER 40.5 L.A. RAMS 20 Chicago 16. Rematch of last year when the Bears upset the Rams 15-6 in the cold (Goff 4 INT's). The Bears broke their losing streak last week but they were out-gained 357-226 and that came against a backup QB for the Lions. Meanwhile, the Rams offense was pathetic last week managing 1 of 14 on 3rd down and just 3 points (defense scored 9) in the loss to the Steelers.
