YARD USE POLICY

Southern Vales Dressage Club grounds have a number of yards that are available for use on competition days for a fee nominated by the Southern Vales Dressage Club Committee.

The yards for competitors are located on the northern side of the grounds. The yards for Committee members are located behind the Clubrooms.

Procedure for booking and allocating yards on competition days:

1. People who require a yard:
 - a. Fill in the relevant section on the Southern Vales Dressage Club entry form.
 - b. Include the yard fee with the Southern Vales Dressage Club Entry Form and charges to the Draw Secretary.

2. The Draw Secretary receives the yard requests and prioritises allocation on the following basis:

Priority One:	Southern Vales Dressage Club members
Priority Two:	Non-members

Horses must not be tied to the yards or gates.

Horses in yards must not be left unattended.

Horses that are not competing on the day are not allowed in yards or on the grounds.

Yards must be cleaned after use and manure scattered around trees and shrubs on the grounds (please avoid contact with trunks).
