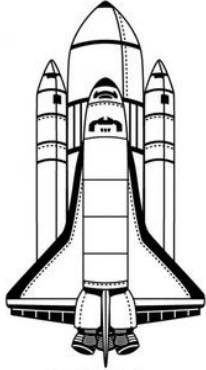

# Pat Reid Baby Quilt Contest Fact Sheet

Pat Reid was a beloved member of the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. who passed away in 2013. Her love of quilting was mainly dedicated to the making of baby quilts and she chaired the Lullaby Baby Quilt Committee for the Guild for many years.

On May 8, 2013 the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. established the Pat Reid Award, the award will be presented each year to the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. member who's baby quilt was selected from those quilts entered in the Pat Reid Baby Quilt Contest. A \$25.00 cash prize is awarded to the First Place Winner.

The requirements are:

- All techniques accepted: pieced, appliqued, embroidery.
- The finished quilt should be no smaller than 36" x 36" and no larger than 40" x 54"
- Members may enter as many completed quilts as they desire ➤ The Guild will not provide any fabric and/or supplies for the quilt
- Quilt must be received by the deadline or it will not be eligible to be judged

The quilts will be displayed, and the winner announced at the Business Meeting, Following the close of the contest.

Quilts will become property of Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. and be distributed in accordance with the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. goals and objectives when the Contest is completed.

Criteria:

★ Contest limited to Members only. Members may enter as many completed quilts as they desire.

★ Guild members that reside out of state may submit a quilt by mail

★ All techniques will be accepted: pieced, appliqued, embroidery

★ Baby quilt should be no smaller than 36" x 36" and no larger than 40" x 54"

★ Each quilt must be a fully finished quilt. No fabric and/or supplies will be provided by the guild

★ All quilts will be donated to Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc.

★ Any quilt which is submitted must be received by the deadline or it will not be eligible to be judged

★ All baby quilts are to be submitted by April 13th to contest Chairperson

★ **All the Baby Quilts that meet these criteria will be judged and prizes awarded.**

Submission of this application means that you have read the form and the attached fact sheet and agree with the conditions of the contest.

## Machine Applique by Jeanette

April 6<sup>th</sup> Class 9:00am St Gabe's Church

Items Needed:

Sewing machine – preferably with auto or knee lift, open toe applique foot, embroidery needle #75,

Fabric – 6" square 1 light green and 1 dark green Fabric Scraps – orange dark and light, white, dark brown, light brown

Wonder Under – two 5" squares

Thread 60wt or rayon – darker orange, white, dark brown, light brown, and an empty bobbin

Pencil, scissors for paper, Teflon ironing mat (if you have one)

### Large Quilter's Tote Materials List

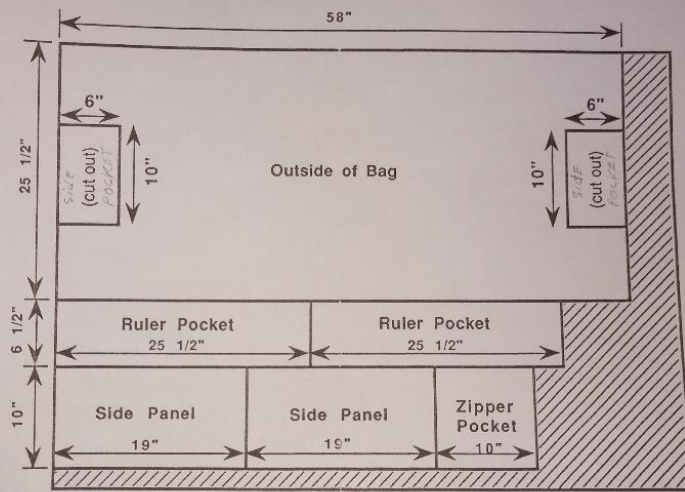
- 1 3/4 yds of outside fabric
- 2 1/2 yds of lining fabric
- 1/2 yard of coordinating fabric  
(if making a pocket for the outside of tote)
- 1 3/4 yds of fusible pellaon
- Thread to match outside and lining
- 7" zipper
- 1" piece of velcro
- Name Label
- 2 pieces of dowel  
3/4" wide x 23" long
- Sewing Machine
- General Sewing Kit
- 9" x 24" piece of heavyweight

**Homework:** Please make a 16" square for outside pocket, if desired. You must have the bag and the lining cut prior to class. If you have any questions on the layout, please stop by before the day of the class.


**Suggestion:** Do try to avoid directional fabric for this tote. It'll make your life easier!



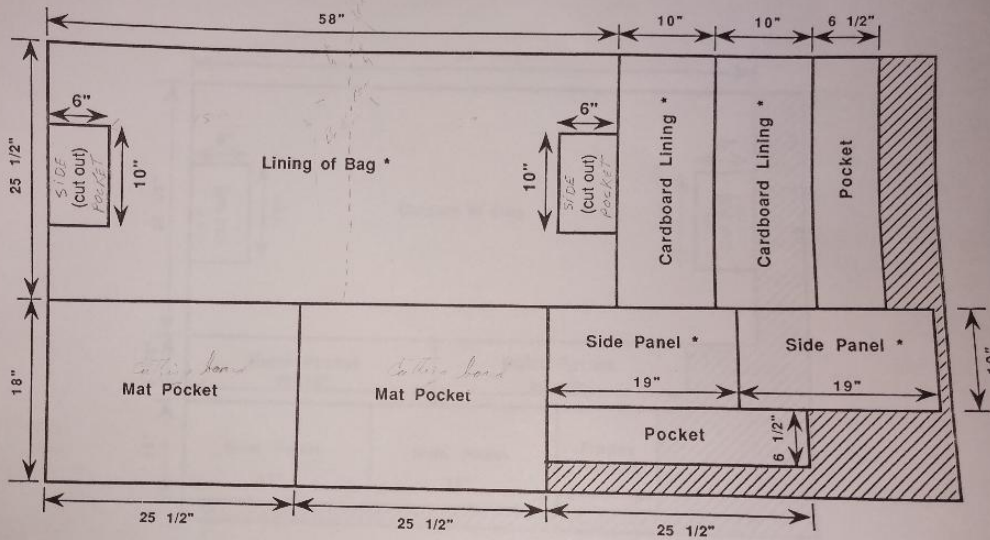
### LAYOUT FOR OUTSIDE FABRIC
