ABBOTTS RUN POOL RULES

- **1.** For security and insurance reasons, the gate must be always locked. It is understood that residents may use the pool at their own discretion, as no lifeguard is on duty.
- **2.** Children under 14 must be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult 18 or over.
- **3.** Residents are advised not to swim alone.
- **4.** No glass or other breakable items are to be used around the pool.
- **5.** No running or otherwise unsafe behavior is allowed.
- **6.** All residents must show courtesy to other users of the facility i.e. no water fights, no throwing objects, no large watercraft, etc. that may be disruptive to others.
- 7. Pool hours are from 9:00 am to sundown.
- **8.** No gum is allowed in the pool and surrounding area.
- **9.** Residents MUST accompany guests at all times.
- **10.** All trash and personal articles must be picked up and removed when leaving the premises.
- 11. All umbrellas MUST be put down (CLOSED) after use.
- **12.** Residents are advised not to use the pool when chemicals are applied during the maintenance and cleaning process.
- **13.** Throwing pool furniture in the pool is considered vandalism. Any resident or their guest caught throwing pool furniture in the pool will have their rights to use the neighborhood amenities suspended as per ARTICLE VI; Section 3, of the Abbotts Run Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions.
- **14.** Any damage caused by vandalism from any resident(s), the Association will have the right to bill the resident(s) for total cost of repairs.
- **15.** No animals are allowed in the Pool. No animals, except service animals, are allowed inside the pool enclosure.
