I would like to offer words of thanks to Lisa Hauck and Grace Zimmerman for the work that they have done for Saint Wenceslaus Parish in coordinating our religious education program. I would also like to offer words of thanks to Carrissa Pietz for her leadership for Saint John the Baptist Parish. Offering religious education to our students cannot happen without the many hours that our parishioners have given to teach our students. As we move towards the end of the school year the transition to summer will happen and many of you will be here, there, and everywhere for different activities and time for vacation. With this in mind, I encourage you to look ahead for Mass times if you won't be home and to keep an eye on ministry schedules to make sure that you are around or find a substitute when you are assigned for a ministry. I am looking forward to this coming summer for a few reasons. I will complete a full year of being pastor of both parishes in July. I will also get broken in with experiencing Czech Days. Lastly, I will be able to enjoy the summer months instead of packing and leaving as I did last summer. In July, I will be joining our youth going to the Steubenville Youth Conference in Rochester, MN. I attended these conferences when I was in high school but I have not attended one as a priest.

Last weekend I offered a comment in my homily about a custom that has developed in Hispanic communities in regards to Saint Thomas' response to seeing Jesus after the resurrection. I did not intend to convey the idea that we should start doing this or to use the words 'My Lord and my God' as a replacement for the word 'Amen' when you are presented with the Body or Blood of Christ. I offered this comment to reinforce the reality that each time Mass is celebrated Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity is made present under the forms of bread and wine.

From time to time I refer to Saint Josemaria Escriva in my homilies or in the bulletin. He founded *Opus Dei* (The Work of God) in 1928 and this organization exists in several countries throughout the world. There are three booklets of his quotations that provide insight into different topics such as: character, holy purity, study, love of God, generosity, sincerity, ambition, friendship, struggle, defeat, work, eternity, etc. These topics are timeless and I think that Saint Josemaria's advice is timeless as well. I am not formally connected with *Opus Dei* but I try to implement parts of their way of life into my own life. The lives of the saints are important because the saints desired to imitate Jesus in several aspects of their lives. There are certain saints whose writings, apostolic work, witness, etc. that will resonate with some people but not with others and that is ok. For some (converts especially) the saints can be a little difficult to understand in particular when we ask for their prayers. A common misconception is that Catholics give the same worship to saints that we give to God. This is not true because we honor the saints and give special honor to Mary. In Greek the word for praise or worship is *latria* and the word *dulia* refers to the honor given to saints and hyper *dulia* is given to Mary.

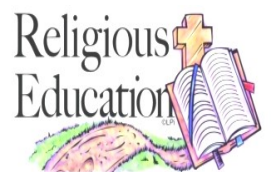
