

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2019-12**

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO APPOINTING  
JONATHON McLEMORE TO THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME GENERAL MAINTENANCE  
WORKER 1 FOR AMELIA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, a vacancy has occurred in the Public Works Department of Amelia Village for a full-time general maintenance worker 1; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has recommended the appointment Jonathon McLemore to the fill the full-time general maintenance worker 1, on a probationary basis.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio that:

**SECTION I.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint Jonathon McLemore to the position of full-time general maintenance worker 1 on a probationary basis for Amelia Village, Ohio effective February 27, 2019.

**SECTION II.** This appointment is contingent on the appointee passing a pre-employment physical and drug screening prior to beginning employment. The Mayor is authorized to determine that Mr. McLemore has satisfactorily completed the probation period after the six-month period.

**SECTION III.** This position requires the employee to be CDL Class B certified prior to employment or be able to become certified within six months of employment and to maintain this CDL Class B certification during employment. Failure to meet and maintain this condition of employment may mean possible termination.

**SECTION IV.** Council hereby confirms the appointment of Jonathon McLemore to the position of full-time general maintenance worker 1 on a six-month probationary basis, effective February 27, 2019.

**SECTION V.** Jonathon McLemore will begin employment at the hourly rate of fifteen dollars per hour (\$15.00) during said probationary period and needs to obtain a Class B CDL license.

**SECTION VI.** Scheduling work of said full-time employee shall be at the direction of the Mayor. Said full-time employee may generally be scheduled to work approximately forty (40) hours per week, unless the Mayor directs fewer or additional hours by emergency or necessity.

**SECTION VII.** Jonathon McLemore shall be employed as an at will employee of the Village subject to all applicable rules and regulations contained in the Amelia Village Employee Manual as amended from time to time, and other such rules and regulations as the Village Council may determine from time to time are in the best interest of Amelia Village.

**SECTION VIII.** Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

**SECTION IX.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is

necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order to enable the Village to fulfill its statutory obligations to maintain its public streets and grounds. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of a supermajority of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. FISCHER moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MR. FITE seconded the motion.
