Accommodations: CASA NOSTRA casa particular, and nearby casas particulares in the top-quality CasaHostalCuba Group, Vedado. Casa Nostra will be the central group meeting place before departures. The casas are located not far from Plaza de la Revolución. Casa rooms are private, with private (not shared with other rooms) bath.

Departure Airport: Tampa International Airport (TIA)

- Wednesday, November 8, 2017: Tampa-Havana, TBA when new schedules become available
- Saturday, November 12, 2017: Havana-Tampa, return flight TBA when schedule is available

Program

This is a Cultural and Educational Exchange geared toward directly experiencing the people and activity, seeing history-making changes taking place, learning history, and enjoying the beauty all around you while pursuing your craft or interest in photography or travel. **We are traveling as a group under only US license Category 6B (see Travel Affidavit) for Cuba cultural-educational exchanges**, not tourism that still is not permitted to date for US passport holders, or for any commercial purposes, such as commercial photography or journalism.

Bobbi Lane and Lee Varis (www.bobbilanephotography.com) will provide photography instruction and guidance before, during and after your daily cultural-educational exchange activities, many with photo shoots. We will visit cultural locations and special photo shoot locations, together as a group and in small groups with a leader. You will have a chance to interact with the Cuban people and see them go about their daily lives. Contact your photography leader with any questions on *photography and photography program content*. Contact the Group Organizer for *registration, insurance, and travel-related details*.

PROGRAM DETAILS (Subject to minor adjustments and modifications; events and venues will be included.)

Day 1 - Tuesday, November 8 - L, D HAVANA

Our stay and home base is the **Casa Nostra (and associated casas particulares)** in Vedado.

1. 5:00 am Check-In Tampa International Airport. Take hotel shuttles to airport starting 4 am.
2. 8:00 am Departure to Havana, on flight with a major airline carrier
3. 9:30/10:30 am Arrival José Martí International Airport, Havana, Cuba
4. TRANSFER to Old Havana, with running history commentary by guide on the ride from airport, for lunch at **Santo Angel** paladar.

(Time will not permit stops to do photography, shop or buy cigars and rum.)

5. 3:00 pm – 5:00 pm After lunch TRANSFER DIRECTLY to John Lennon Park for afternoon instruction by leaders.
6. 5:30 pm Hotel Check-in at Casas Particulares.
7. 7 pm Dinner at **Decameron paladar** or similar.
8. Rest of evening free to explore Havana at night.

Suggestion: Take an evening tour in a taxi particular on your own, joining other group members, at approximately CUC30 total for the taxi (not included.)

Day 2 – Wednesday, November 9 - B, L, D – HAVANA TO VALLE DE VIÑALES

1. 7:00 am Breakfast at the casas.
2. 8:00 am Departure to **Las Terrazas** and **Viñales**
3. Along the way, your leaders will discuss the program for today and the rest of the time here.
4. Have a special coffee (not included) in Hotel Moka and buy some coffee. Allow one hour.
5. Continue to Viñales. Time to see views at the Las Jasmynes overlook (landscape, mogotes, farmland), shop for gifts, and send a postcard back home.
6. **Eco-Farm (finca)** visit and **Lunch at Finca Paraíso**, included. Guide or farm staff will show group around the farm and give commentary on the eco-friendly operations. (required)
7. Visit a working **tobacco farm** in **Viñales** and learn about tobacco farming and cigar production. Buy some cigars.
8. Return to Casas in Havana by approximately 6:00 pm to prepare for the evening. On the return bus trip, leaders will prepare you for the morning shoot, including lighting, composition, portraiture, architecture, and more.
9. 8:00 pm Transfer to **Paladar Mediterraneo Havana** for dinner.

Day 3 - Thursday, November 10 – B, L, D – HAVANA

1. 6:00 am Meet at Casa Nostra and walk the area with leaders up to the Colón Cemetery. Entry is 6:30 am (entry ticket is included) for sunrise shoot.
2. 8:30 am Breakfast at Casa Nostra.
3. 9:30 am Leaders will give a follow-up presentation on light and lighting and discuss morning shoot.
4. 10:30 am Transfer to the nearby Farmer's Market (19 y B) to observe daily life of Cubans.
5. 12:00 pm Transfer to Old Havana for LUNCH at **El Templete**.
6. 1:30 – 3:30 pm Guide will take us on a walking tour of four of the **Five Plazas**, including **Plaza Vieja**, allowing time at each plaza for photography.

7. 3:30 pm- 5:00 pm Transfer to **José Fuster Gallery**. Photographers will visit the gallery, perhaps meet Senor Fuster, and do street photography.
8. 5:00 – 6 pm Transfer back to hotel.
9. 7:30 pm Transfer to dinner at **Ivan Chef Justo paladar** in Old Havana.
10. 9:30 pm Transfer back to casas. Rest of evening is free.

Day 4 - Friday, November 11– B, L, D

1. 6:00 am Gather at Casa Nostra and share taxi particulares to waterfront at Malecon for a sunrise shoot on the water (not included).
2. Return by 8:30 am for breakfast.
3. 8:30 am Breakfast at Casa Nostra.
4. 9:30 am – 12 pm Transfer to the Habana Queen **Salsa School** for portraiture and viewing of performances. *Group members will bring items to give to dance school, such as warmers, tights, and scarves.
5. 12:00 pm Transfer to Cojimar to waterfront to see bust of Hemingway, castle and sea.
6. 1:00 pm LUNCH at **Café Ajiaco** in Cojimar.
7. 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm Transfer to the Museo Hemingway.
8. 5:00pm Transfer to Morro Castle for landscape and water views of Havana and visit the exterior of castle, in late afternoon light (no entry to museum.) Leaders will provide guidance on outdoor photography through sunset at approximately 7 pm.
9. 7:30 pm Return to hotel to prepare for the evening.
10. 8:30 pm– Transfer to Café Taberna and the **Benny Moré All-Stars** for **FAREWELL DINNER AND PERFORMANCE** (included.)
11. 11:00 pm Transfer back to hotel.

Day 5 - Saturday, November 12, 2017

On day five, we will say goodbye to Cuba. We will transfer in the morning from hotel to airport for customs clearance and the return flight, arriving at Tampa at approximately 10:30 – 11:30 am; retrieve your checked luggage and go through customs, **allowing a minimum of five hours after arrival** before connecting flights.

PROGRAM AND REGISTRATION DETAILS

Participants should know that Cuba is a special destination. Please understand that all elements of this itinerary are subject to change and that the times and activities listed above are approximate. The Leader/Ground Manager reserves the right to move event times around during the day for weather conditions or other factors. **Price per person includes R/T Airfare (Tampa-Havana), hotel, ground transportation (bus transfers), Cuba Entry Visa, Cuba Health Insurance while in country, and meals indicated as “included” or in Uppercase Letters above each daily list and on the detailed itinerary; photography instruction; and entry fees indicated in program.** Entry fees and meals not included are listed as “not included or “on your own.” We reserve the right to make a price increase adjustment, should fewer persons register than expected. We fully expect and anticipate meeting the minimum group size. **Deposits are due IMMEDIATELY to hold airline seats and hotel/casas spaces (Both are in very high demand!)** **Final Balance is due, at YButler Group offices, no later than September 8, 2017.**

Price of Program* also includes:

Your travel to/from Tampa, local stay in Tampa, airport parking, meals, and related personal travel items are at your expense. Excess baggage weight and checked baggage fees; tips and gratuities for guides, drivers, and servers; and personal items and purchases are also yours.

Bring for departure: Passport, copy of Cuba Affidavit, \$20 per checked bag, \$25 departure tax, and \$2/lb., if you have excess weight luggage over the total 44 lb. limit per person.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENTS: A **\$500 non-refundable deposit** is due with registration to hold and reserve a space. Given the general year-round scarcity of hotel rooms in Havana and high demand for rooms for the high season, we request that you submit a deposit and all paperwork at your very earliest convenience. The group size minimum is twelve (12) persons. When twelve spots are filled, we will add your name and contact information to the Alternates List. If someone cancels, person at top of list will be notified.

A Complete Initial Registration includes: (a) \$500 non-refundable deposit; and electronically-scanned copies of: (b) Cuba Registration form, (c) Copy of first page of your US passport (valid at least six months AFTER our return date), and (d) Cuba Travel Affidavit (Check Category 6B for educational travel).
