

"I can suck my thumb now!" The baby now sleeps and awakens. Fingernails and toenails form and (s)he now has his/her own unique set of fingerprints. Sensitive to touch, (s)he will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of his/her hand. (S)he breathes amniotic fluid to help develop and strengthen the respiratory system, but (s)he gets the oxygen (s)he needs through the umbilical cord.
