Whereas, As Catholic women, who are servant leaders, we are asked to let our light shine by wisely using our God-given gifts to share our Catholic faith as we address the needs of our church and communities both locally and globally; and

Whereas, Since councils are struggling from decreased membership and women willing to take on leadership roles yet recognizing we must remain committed to do whatever we can do to further God's Kingdom; therefore, be it

Resolved, That as Catholic women of faith, we shall open ourselves to God's call and allow His grace to work within us as we joyfully share the love language of Christ to include performing Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy during the ongoing pandemic;

Resolved, That we will move beyond ourselves for the sake of others by stepping out of our comfort zone in our journey to achieve our council mission and act on the needs of God's people; and

Resolved, That we, as Sisters in Christ, shall actively and enthusiastically encourage, support, and mentor other council members in an effort to let our lights shine and build our membership as well as support and promote council programs and activities.

HEALING RACISM

Resolution approved at NCCW 2021 Convention for affiliate council participation. *(Slight word changes for our diocesan councils)*

Purpose:

At the 2022 NCCW annual convention, each NCCW Province will be able to name at least one action the diocesan, deanery, and parish affiliate councils in their province have taken to begin reducing racism in their personal lives, in their councils and/or in their communities.

Whereas, Racism is a sinful, learned, negative behavior of prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism against others of a particular race or ethnicity (<u>https://www.lexico.com/en/definition/racism</u>);

Whereas, Racism disrespects human life and dignity and brings injustice and illness to our national and individual souls; and

Whereas, Racism can cause great emotional, mental, and spiritual harm to both the person expressing this belief and those experiencing the effects of this belief; therefore, be it

Resolved, That all DCCW (NCCW) members will pray and promote the NCCW Prayer to Love: Healing Racism (<u>www.nccw.org</u> —>Explore NCCW Prayer) to assist in eradicating racism and empowering council members, through the grace of the Holy Spirit, to become missionary disciples;

Resolved, That DCCW (NCCW) members educate ourselves and others by studying Open Wide Our Hearts, The Enduring Call to Love, a Pastoral Letter found on the NCCW website (<u>www.nccw.org</u> →NCCW News). Resolved, That we encourage all members to invite women of all races and ethnicities to join, become involved in our councils and to share equally in the benefits and responsibilities for the direction and development of our councils and our communities.
