St. Valentine – February 14th

St. Valentine, as the legends say, was a 3rd century Bishop and martyr. It's said he was imprisoned for marrying soldiers in secret because at the time that St. Valentine lived it was illegal for soldiers to have wives. St. Valentine is said to have healed his jailer's daughter for blindness and written her a letter that he signed "from your Valentine", which is where our custom of giving 'valentine's' originates from.
