





<u>Active Membership REQUIRED:</u>

- 80% Meeting Attendance by Advisor **OR** Parent/Community Liaison
 - 5 General Meetings (September, November, January, March, May)
 - 80% = 4 Mtgs minimum
- This allows access to RPM Fund Balances
- Inactive Status Account Fund Balance goes On-Hold until Active Status can be reached.

• PROPER USE:




