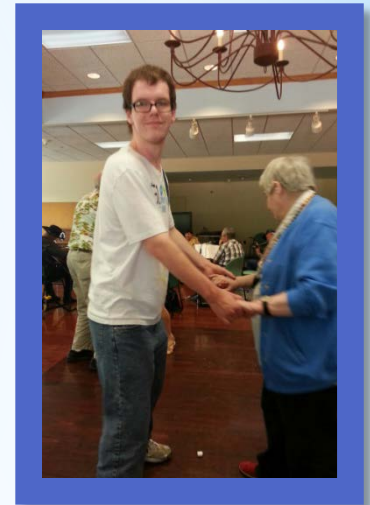


Program Goals
