PROCEDURE FOR FILING A CLAIM IN SMALL CLAIMS COURT

If your claim is in the amount of \$3,000.00 or less and the defendant resides, has a place of business or employment in the Town of Dix, you may use the Town of Dix Small Claims Court.

To file a claim, the plaintiff (person making the claim) must supply the name and exact address of the defendant (person against whom claim is made). If a claim is against a business firm, you <u>must know whether or not it is incorporated</u>. If it is, the suit must be brought against the corporation, using its proper name. If the business is not incorporated, you must know the owner's name and address. Such information is available in the Schuyler County Clerk's Office, 105 Ninth Street, Watkins Glen, NY.

If the claim is for \$1,000.00 or less, the cost of filing is \$10.00. If the claim exceeds \$1,000.00, the cost of filing is \$15.00. Postage for mailings is included in the filing fee.

If your claim is settled before the return date, kindly notify the court in writing so that the matter can be taken off the court's calendar.

At the time of the Small Claims Hearing, be prepared with all of your evidence, witnesses, etc. that you will need to prove your case.
