

Who Are You?

Interview and Presentation

First, you will **interview** a classmate using the questions below.

Second, you will **write one paragraph** about that person that will eventually be memorized and presented.

Then, you'll gather five photos from that person and put them into a **PowerPoint** presentation.

Finally, you'll **show the PowerPoint and give your presentation** about your classmate.

This project will require you to use your listening, speaking, and writing skills.
Each part of this project will be graded separately.

Timeline:

- Monday, 10/21: Learn project requirements.
- Thursday, 10/24: Interview a partner who doesn't speak the same first language as you (if possible).
For homework, send him/her your pictures and get pictures from him/her.
- Thursday, 10/25: Begin writing a paragraph about your partner.
For homework, finish writing your paragraph about your partner.
- Monday, 10/28: Turn in your paragraph for editing. You'll get it back before the end of class.
Work on your PowerPoint presentation and send it to Mrs. Hopkins.
For homework, begin memorizing your paragraph about your classmate.
- Tuesday, 10/29: After working on your vocabulary, work on memorizing your paragraph.
For homework, finish memorizing your paragraph.
- Thursday, 10/31: Give your presentation!
Turn in your final paragraph.
Turn in your interview questions.

Interview Questions:

*You **MUST** ask these questions, listen to the answer, and write your classmate's answer. **DO NOT** just have your partner write his answers on your sheet.*

1. What important information can you tell me about you and your family? (examples: age, home country, family members' names)

2. What is a funny story from your childhood?

3. What are three interesting, little-known things about you?

4. What issue or topic concerns you and why does it concern you?

5. What's one goal you have and why is it your goal?
