Which is the purpose of this hearing.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

There was concern that this would affect other residents in Miami Park financially. It was explained that it would only affect the four individuals who presented the petition.

The other question was would this prevent walking the beach and losing beach front because of these four homeowners. Debbie Weaver explained that this revetment will help with drainage, it is a better plan this one will have a path along the Lake shore from Miami to Pacific. There will be a beach if the water is down, if the water is up there will not be any beach anyway.

As of this time there are not any plans. It was asked if everyone will get a notice when there are plans. Allan explained that it is the law that we are only required to send notice to the property owners that would be in the Special Assessment district, there will be a notice in the paper though. Allan reassured some individuals that the only ones that would pay for this would be the ones that are in the special assessment district. No other Miami Park individuals will be responsible for the cost of the project.

There was a plan, but one of the four petitioners dropped out, so we must start over.

Dan made a motion to adjourn. Kenny supported. All votes in favor. Motion Carried.
