Two Harbors resident Judy Anderson says she knows for a fact that law enforcement officers can use a boost, and you could call it her mother's intuition that informs her. Anderson is the proud mother of Two Harbors Assistant Chief Ken Anderson.

"They do such a good job, I just wanted to do something to boost their morale," said Anderson.

So she started talking to friends, and pretty soon a small group came together to order yard signs that say "Thank you Law Enforcement Officers". Anderson says they quickly found 50 yards wanting to host the signs, and have even found local businesses willing to recognize law enforcement on their own business signs.

Anderson and friends are planning a three-day law enforcement recognition spanning September 15, 16, and 17, with a community parade planned for the 16<sup>th</sup>.

"We wanted to get the whole community involved to build their spirits up and let them know we are standing behind them," Anderson stated.

Currently seeking community members across Lake County to join the parade, Anderson says that some people will be on foot, but they are hoping to have as many cars as possible join the parade.

The parade will line up at 12:30 pm on Wednesday, September 16<sup>th</sup> starting at the parking lot near the treatment plant in Two Harbors (corner of Park Rd./1st Street and South Ave.), and will swing past the law enforcement building. "We want everybody who sees a police officer in those three days to greet them and say thank you," said Anderson, who is also looking for volunteers to write thank you notes to law enforcement.

Anderson said she also wanted to extend her thanks to all the law enforcement officers in the area, including the Lake County Sheriff and the Silver Bay Police Department.

And her motherly feelings?

"I pray for him (Two Harbors Asst. Police Chief Ken Anderson) every single day and pray for the angels to go with him and all the officers," said Anderson.
