

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PETITION CIRCULATORS

- **Make sure to print both pages of the petition on one piece of paper. Back to back. The State of California will not count the signatures if the entire petition is not on one piece of paper. Be careful that the text is not reduced on printing. 1" from the top of paper to text is correct.**
- **Petitions proposing initiative amendments must only be signed by persons who are **Registered Voters** in the State of California at the time of signing. No out of state signatures and **NO non-registered voters**. Signers can register at the time of signing. Forms available at Post Office.**
- **A person can only sign a petition that is being circulated in his or her county of registration. A petition can only be signed once.**
- **If a petition circulator is a registered voter, he or she may sign the petition he or she is circulating.**
- **Each signer must personally place on the petition his or her signature, printed name, residence address (or physical description of the location if there is no street address), and the name of the incorporated city or unincorporated community. No PO Boxes can be used as an address.**
- **Use black or dark blue ink only. No colored inks**
- **The printed name of the circulator must be on the petition.**
- **The dates between which all the signatures affixed to the petition were obtained.**
- **The declaration must be signed.**

We have till May 20th, 2014 to circulate petitions and collect over one million signatures.
