

Blue Hill UMC

Scholarship Application

A maximum scholarship of \$500 will be granted based upon availability of interest money accrued and the number of successful applicants. Students who have shown Christian leadership in their church, school, and community will be considered.

The following criteria will be used for granting scholarships:

1. The applicant must be an active member of the Blue Hill UMC.
2. Applicant must be a graduate of a high school and enrolled in a full-time degree program in an accredited 2- or 4-year college or university. Money will be awarded upon registration for the 2nd semester of the award year, following successful completion of the 1st semester.
3. Applicant must demonstrate Christian leadership in the Blue Hill United Methodist Church. Regular attendance at worship services, teaching or assisting a teacher with Sunday School classes or Bible School on a regular basis, and being an active member of the youth group are examples of Christian leadership within the church.
4. Two letters of recommendation from a non-relative, i.e., teacher, counselor, church member, or community member must accompany the scholarship application.
5. Applicant must write a letter to the scholarship committee stating why applicant is deserving of the scholarship. Included in the letter must be the applicant's service work history to organizations or people within the community.

Applications are due on the first Friday of April of the applicant's graduation year. Application forms are available from the Blue Hill United Methodist church office or on the church's website www.bluehillbladenumc.org.

Scholarship money will be paid jointly to the college and the applicant at the beginning of the 2nd semester to be applied towards tuition. Both must endorse the check.
