PERMANENT FUNDING FOR TEF SCHOLARSHIPS THROUGH ENDOWMENT FUNDS

It is exciting that many of our scholarships are permanently funded through our partnership with the Blue Mountain Community Foundation (website: www.bluemountainfoundation.org). Our endowment funds with BMCF are professionally managed as part of their very large investment portfolio.

When a TEF scholarship is set up as endowment fund, the donation is deposited with BMCF. The minimum contribution is \$10,000 and funds can be added at any time. Each year, a distribution of earnings is made from BMCF for each endowment fund with a principle balance of at least \$10,000. The idea is that earnings on a \$10,000 endowment fund will provide a scholarship of approximately \$500. Due to market fluctuations, balances have sometimes fallen below the \$10,000 level and/or yearly distributions are less than \$500.

Our goal is to increase the principle balances of all our endowment funds so the annual distributions will increase to make larger scholarship awards possible in the future. Please consider a donation today.

TEF ENDOWMENT FUNDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

FBLA Scholarship in memory of Alvin & Mary'O Adams \$21,574

Founded in 2013 by their children, this scholarship is in honor of Alvin (class of 1938) and Mary'O Adams to promote interest in business and service to the community. The endowment balance was essentially doubled in 2018 with an additional donation by their son, Sam (class of 1963).

Touchet Gun Club Scholarship \$25,787

The TGC had owned a club house and shooting range on Touchet North Road since 1947. In 2006, the members voted to sell the property and donate the proceeds of \$26,000 to TEF. The contribution was used to establish an endowment fund to support scholarships for graduates.

Alumni Scholarship funded by Oscar Ferrians \$10,658

Established as an endowed scholarship in 2014 with a generous \$10,000 donation made by Oscar Ferrians, class of 1946.



Founded in 2013 by Dave's family, this scholarship is for a student who attends a college in Oregon. He grew up in Klamath Falls, graduated from Oregon State University, moved here in 1972 with his wife, Sandy, and was involved in everything Touchet!

Education Scholarship in memory of Helen & Elbert Durfee \$12,585

Started in 2003, Mr. Durfee funded it as an endowment in 2014, as a permanent award for a worthy student pursuing a degree in education. After his passing in 2015, the scholarship is awarded in memory of Mr. and Mrs. Durfee.

Medical Science Scholarship in memory of Robert McCubbins \$12,098

Established in 2009 by his sister Malinda, this endowed scholarship in memory of Robert (class of 1977) is for a student interested in a field of medicine, such as nursing, radiology or EMT.

Eileen Collier Continuing Education Scholarship \$20,986

Eileen (Cummins) Collier, class of 1919, left a contribution to TEF when she passed away at the age of 102. The distribution from the endowment fund provides for a Continuing Education scholarship for a past Touchet graduate at a 4 year college or university.

TEF General Endowment Fund \$48,145



TEF Community Scholarships

In addition to all of our endowed scholarships, there are many other community scholarships available to students through the TEF scholarship application process each spring.

Leadership Scholarship in memory of Paul Garbe & Wilbur Garbe, Jr.

In memory of 2 brothers who died tragically, this scholarship was established in 1971 by Wilbur Garbe, Jr.'s widow, Elaine.

The Wilbur Garbe family has provided funding for this scholarship.

Tri-Community Homemakers Scholarship

This local women's service club has given a scholarship since 1978. This is an academic scholarship, which the group continues to fund each year.

Friendship Scholarship in memory of Robert McCubbins

Created in 2008 to honor Robert's (class of 1977) memory of being giving and generous to others, this scholarship is awarded to a student who is friendly, helpful, kind and caring towards others. It is funded each year by Michael & Julie McCubbins.

FFA Scholarship in memory of Roy Kregger

This scholarship was started by his wife, Marguerite, after Mr. Kregger's death. It recognizes a student that exhibits outstanding involvement & leadership in the Touchet FFA. Funds are provided by the Kregger family and Touchet FFA Chapter.

FFA Scholarship in memory of Richard Garbe

After Mr. Garbe's (class of 1956) passing in 2017, his family set up this scholarship to recognize a senior member of the Touchet FFA Chapter who has achieved the FFA State Farmer Award. Funding has come from Dick's family, as well as from the memorial contributions we received in his name.

Making a Difference Scholarship in memory of Katie Nolan

This continuing education scholarship was established in 2010 by her family, to encourage others to follow Katie's (class of 1998) example of service to others. She was working on a Master's degree in social work when she died in a climbing accident on Mt. Hood in 2009. The scholarship is funded each year by the Fulgham & Nolan family.

Continuing Education Scholarship in memory of Ron Dunning, Jr.

An FFA scholarship has been given in memory of Ron since his passing in 1986, the summer after graduating from THS. The Dunning family chose to change the focus of his memorial scholarship beginning in 2018. The new scholarship is awarded as a general continuing education scholarship to assist past graduates at a 4 year college or university.

Where do contributions to area of "greatest need" go?

Our policy has been to award a basic TEF Merit Scholarship to every senior that participates in our fundraising and submits a complete application by the deadline. Since 2012, that basic scholarship has been \$1,000 per student. Depending on class size, we have awarded \$14,000—\$26,000 just in basic scholarships. The fundraiser, memorial contributions, and general donations fund these basic scholarships.

Continuing Education (Junior Standing) Scholarships—due date May 15, 2019

Eligibility: junior standing or above, enrolled at an accredited four year college/university to complete an undergraduate or graduate degree, minimum 2.75 college GPA.

Class of 2018 (2nd Year) Scholarships due date July 15, 2019

Eligibility: student enrolled at an accredited institution, have earned a minimum 36 college level credits (quarter) or 24 college level credits (semester), minimum 2.75 college GPA.
