The MIAA Power Rankings will be the "base-line" criteria used by the Realignment Committee to form all leagues. Power Rankings for the previous FOUR seasons will be calculated using the following weighted formula: [(Most Recent) Year 1-50%, Year 2- 30%, Year 3-15%, Year 4-5%] Beyond this formula, the Realignment Committee will also factor the following criteria into their overall decision-making process, when determining league placement (in no particular order):

- MIAA Divisional Alignment (this factors in school size and competitive equity multiplier)
- Geography attempts should be made to limit travel times within leagues where possible
- Record within current league structure

Beyond the above criteria, the Realignment Committee for each sport will request Athletic Director input via an AD Realignment Input Form, prior to each realignment meeting. This form will provide the Committee with information that MAY be used when considering final placement of teams within leagues. The form is optional, but gives AD's a chance to address any issues or concerns with the Committee PRIOR to placement in a league.

Examples of AD Input:

Our program has all of our varsity players returning and we would prefer the most challenging schedule possible.

Our program graduated our entire starting line-up and we will struggle based on our previous power rankings.

Please eliminate cross-over games in this sport because those games have not been competitive.

We struggle to find independent games so the more assigned games the better.

Geographical match-ups in this sport are very important to our program and our available transportation. Anything else the AD would like the realignment committee to be aware of.
