From the President's Desk: February 2016

There will be a vote by written ballot at the February 16th chapter meeting on a proposed by law change. This issue will be decided by simple majority, and if it passes will take effect immediately. The vote is to change By-law article VIII, Section A, paragraph one from:

Members in good standing, their immediate family when accompanied by a member, shall be permitted to use the grounds and facilities from sunrise to sunset without permission of the Board. Members in good standing may invite, and must accompany, personal guests, not to exceed six (6) persons, except for the use of the Trap Range, Rifle Range, Pistol Range, and Black Powder Range where only one (1) guest is allowed.

To (with proposed changes underlined):

Members in good standing, <u>and</u> their immediate family when accompanied by a member, shall be permitted to use the grounds and facilities from sunrise to sunset without permission of the Board. Members in good standing may invite, and must accompany, personal guests, not to exceed six (6) persons, except for the use of the <u>Trap</u>, <u>Rifle</u>, and <u>Pistol Ranges</u>, where up to three (3) guests are allowed. The member must accompany and have direct control and supervision at all times of his/her guests while shooting together on a range.




