

## **MIDVIEW ATHLETIC BOOSTERS BYLAWS**

Pursuant to Article II, Section 12 of the Code of Regulation of Midview Athletic Boosters (MAB), the following bylaws are enacted for the government of the body.

### **Section 1: Membership Dues**

The annual dues are set at \$10.00. Any additional donation may be designated for the corporation at large or to a specific sport's account. A membership qualifies one individual to vote.

### **Section 2: Policy & Procedure**

Each sport may form a separate booster organization. These organizations are considered a sub-set of the MAB. These groups shall have a chairperson selected by the membership. Either the chairperson of the sub-set group, the coach or a designee shall attend all MAB meetings. These individuals must be members of the MAB. Because all participants are required to be MAB members to vote, the individual sports shall not require separate dues as a condition of membership. All individual sports booster meeting dates will be forwarded to the Board of Directors and shall be open to their participation.

- i.) The Midview Athletic Boosters (MAB) is ultimately responsible for all phases of fund raising by the Club and associated groups. This encompasses how, when and why fund raising takes place and includes the collection and disbursement of all monies.
- ii.) MAB will maintain separate accounts for all sports.
- iii.) MAB funds shall be spent to directly benefit athletes and the athletic programs only. Individual sports shall spend their money in the same manner with the exception that they focus on their particular sport.
- iv.) All accounts must maintain a positive balance. There is no authorization for any individual, any sport or the organization as a whole to incur debt, without available funds for re-payment.
- v.) All necessary documentation (receipts, etc.) must be presented to the treasurer before any monies are disbursed.
- vi.) All fundraising activities must be submitted in writing to the President of MAB and the Midview Athletic Director for approval. MAB will endeavor to ensure that all traditional fund raisers for the various sports are protected.
- vii.) MAB's budget is primarily intended to support the athletic department as a whole and with expenditures not normally

associated with an individual sport. Coaches requesting MAB funds for an individual sport shall make such request in writing to the Board or Athletic Director for inclusion on the agenda prior to the meeting date.

- viii.) Any request/motion for monies over the amount of \$500.00 per group, per meeting, must receive two (2) readings (at consecutive meetings) prior to passage. This requirement is waived if the request/motion is approved unanimously. The Board of Directors has the right to overrule this requirement on an emergency basis.

### **Section 3: Midview Athletic Boosters Commitment**

The MAB will provide the following support for all member sports:

- i. A \$6.00 monetary stipend for each athlete to be used toward funding the team post season banquet.
- ii. Midview Sports Programs for each season including team picture for all sports.
- iii. Sports awards/Scholarships
- iv. Senior Pictures

### **Section 4: Midview Athletic Boosters Fundraisers**

The MAB expects active participation in the parent organizations fundraisers by all individual sports. To include but not be limited to:

- i. Football and Basketball 50/50 raffles
- ii. Sports Program Sales
- iii. Sectional and Divisional Tournament Concessions
- iv. Membership Drive

### **Section 5: Board of Directors**

The Board of Directors may make decisions on an emergency basis for the entire club. A majority of the Board may transact, without referring to the body for vote, all operating expenses that do not involve a financial expenditure in excess of \$500.00

### **Section 6: Amendments**

These bylaws may be altered in whole or in part by a majority vote of the membership.
