The story of Crime Stoppers began 40 years ago in Albuquerque, New Mexico when a young detective faced difficulties in solving a case involving a fatal shooting of a gas station attendant. In an act of desperation, he approached a local television network to create a reenactment of the crime, seeking the help of the public by offering \$1000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect. All of this with the protection of anonymity to the tipster. The case profile aired and after 72 hours, the case was solved with the arrest of the suspect after a community member called in with information regarding the getaway vehicle. This single case established the foundations for other Crime Stoppers program throughout the country.

This year's conference gives us an opportunity to share knowledge among other Crime Stoppers programs both young and old. We look forward to engaging with members of the various programs throughout the State to share what we have learned and provide each other networking opportunities that further develop your programs and partnerships.
