IN LOVING MEMORY OF VOLUNTEER

Rosemarie Lotspeich had quite an eventful life. She escaped Communist East Germany after the war, married her husband right after coming to America, and had 3 children.

She became a restaurateur and worked tirelessly until she retired at 73 and shortly thereafter ,her husband passed away. Having worked so hard all her life, Rosemary was at a loss for what to do.

She decided to volunteer at the HSNI and became smitten with a little white Bichon mix named **Frankie**, who in the dead of winter was not finding many takers. But because of her age and financial situation,



she felt she could not adopt him, but she visited him nevertheless.

That Valentine's Day one of her sons convinced his siblings that the little dog would give her life new purpose. He secured the paperwork to adopt and planned to trick her. They took Frankie out for a walk and he said, "No one's looking, Let's kidnap him." She got angry and said, ""Take him back in." He then showed her the completed approved adoption papers, and they both broke down in tears.

Frankie became **Schatze** (German for treasure) and he was the treasure of her life from then on, rarely leaving her side.




HSNI Doggie Alumnus Comes to Life In 🛧 Pages of A NEW Children's Book! 太

"BUBBLES' TROUBLES" is not just a children's book about a little dog with no home; it's the story of a dog who found a home through the tireless efforts of The Humane Society of Northwest Indiana.

"Bubbles' Troubles" is the debut offering by first time author, Linda Stone, a 64-year-old Midwesterner who found love and the inspiration for putting pen to paper during a visit to our shelter. In finding New York-based illustrator Matthew Smith to bring the story of Bubbles to life on the pages of her book, Stone began her journey into writing for children.

"I have owned and operated a floral shop in my hometown of New Buffalo, Michigan for the past quarter century. Prior to being a florist, I owned a bakery



for 20 years in Union Pier, Michigan and still decorate cakes and cookies for my customers," said Stone. "I enjoy gardening, crafts, crocheting, puzzles, walking on the beautiful shoreline of Lake Michigan, and spending time with my two rescue dogs, Bubbles and her brother Teddy. They bring me joy every day.'
