## AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS

TOWN OF HAMPTON
COUNTY OF WASHINGTON

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows: .

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of a 62,396 may be expended for general repairs upon 3200 +1 - Feet miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof 2. IMPROVEMENTS.
