
A MESSAGE FROM CHRYSALIS FLIGHT #62 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR



MESSAGE FROM OUR CHRYSALIS COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

Six years ago something happened that made a huge impact on my life and I don't mean my Emmaus walk. I'm talking about Chrysalis. When my Emmaus table leader, Todd Deaver, approached me about serving on a Chrysalis flight, I had never heard of it. Granted my walk had been about a year before, so I wasn't really familiar with Emmaus either. Since that time the relationships I have built serving in the conference room and in the background have blessed my life and my walk in ways that I couldn't imagine.

For those of you that are not familiar with Chrysalis, it is an Emmaus weekend for young men and women that are 15-18 years of age or have completed the 9th grade. The weekend itself is very similar to an Emmaus walk with a few differences. First off the whole atmosphere, both in the conference room and background, is a bit more relaxed. Hey, we are dealing with teenagers here. The talks are basically the same though they have different titles. The caterpillars (what the Chrysalis pilgrims are called) do get two talks not given on an Emmaus walk. The Single Life and Marriage talks are given by a Christian single and couple and give the caterpillars not only an opportunity to listen but to also ask questions about living as a Christian single or married couple. The Candlelight service is different in the unique way communion is held and that's all I'm going to say about that. If you want to know more come to Candlelight! Serenade is different in the fact that it is not a community wide activity but a special program for the caterpillars and conference room team on the last morning. Closing is a the same as on an Emmaus walk with the exception that, instead of just the Emmaus community, the parents of the youth are allowed to attend regardless if they have been on a walk or not. This gives them a chance to see the change in not only their child but the affect the weekend has had on all participants. Hopefully it will encourage them to take the steps to going on an Emmaus walk themselves.

I'm looking forward to the upcoming flight to see the impact on another group of on young women. Shay Baugh, the Flight Lay Director, has assembled a super team. This will actually be the first girls' flight held in a church venue instead of at Camp White Water and I'm excited to see what God has in store! Thanks to everyone for their support for Chrysalis and please be in prayer for the caterpillars, team and workers on flight 62.




