

VILLAGE OF DRYDEN
ELECTION ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 57.3

An ordinance to provide for biennial Village elections in November of even-numbered years; to provide for terms of office for Village officials; and to provide for the extension of terms of office pursuant to Public Act 551 of 2012.

THE VILLAGE OF DRYDEN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Biennial November Elections. Commencing with the November general election in 2014, all elections for Village offices shall be held in November of even-numbered years.

Section 2. Terms of Office. The term of office for the Village President shall be four years. The terms of office of Village Trustees shall also be four years and shall be staggered so that one-half of the terms expire every two years.

Section 3. Extension of Terms of Office. In order to comply with the change in election dates mandated by state statute, the current terms of office of Village officials are extended as follows:

a. The terms of office of the three Village Trustees elected in 2009 are extended to November 20, 2014.

b. The terms of office of the three Village Trustees elected in 2011 are extended to November 20, 2016.

c. The term of office of the Village President elected in 2011 is hereby extended to November 20, 2016.

Section 4. Trustee Terms After 2013. Commencing with the November 2014 election, only two trustees shall be elected every two years pursuant to Section 2 of Dryden Village Ordinance No. 57.2. Trustees shall be elected as follows:

a. Two trustees shall be elected at the November general election in 2014 for four year terms commencing on November 20, 2014.

b. Two trustees shall be elected at the November general election in 2016 for four year terms commencing on November 20, 2016.

Section 5. Repeal of Prior Ordinances. The former Village of Dryden Election Ordinance No. 57.1, adopted on the 1st day of November 2004, is hereby repealed in its entirety. Sections 1 and 4 of Election Ordinance 57.2 are also hereby repealed.

The undersigned Clerk of the Village of Dryden hereby certifies that this ordinance was duly adopted by the Dryden Village Council at a meeting held on the 5th day of March, 2013. This ordinance was published in LA View on the 21st day of March, 2013. This ordinance becomes effective twenty (20) days after the date of adoption.
