

### **Bankruptcy**

Jesus said to his disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit." (John 15:1-2)

As was announced recently, our diocesan church will begin a process of chapter 11 bankruptcy. As I preached on Saturday February 15, the 70th anniversary of the founding of our parish, the pruning of our local church continues. Every branch that bears no fruit must be cut away. Every branch that does bear fruit must be pruned. A particular time of pruning is upon our local church. I look forward to the eventual results of the pruning because it tends to make a tree healthier and better. In the same way, our local church will be made healthier and better as the Lord does his pruning work.
