

MPAC Remodel Project Overview

- In September 2014, the Sun Devil Swimming Association (SDSA) and Sun Devil Club (SDC) kicked off fundraising for a remodel project for the Mona Plummer Aquatics Center (MPAC).
 - SDSA and Sun Devil Athletics agreed that we would be in the facility for at least the next 5-10 years.
 - Improvements need to be made to sustain current program – long term goal is to build a new facility
 - SDSA is working with the SDC to generate donations and “gifts in kind”.
- The purpose of the remodel project is to:
 - Improve team training, morale, and meet performance.
 - Improve recruiting and athlete retention.
 - Enhance the spectator experience.
 - Improve facility revenue generation.

Improvements for Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo

Three Phase Program

- Phase 1 (completed in Spring 2015)
 - Front Landscaping and Pool Logos
 - New swimming starting blocks, power towers
 - Diving training equipment – boards, dry land, and heaters
 - Water Polo – meet clock system
- Phase 2 (beginning Summer 2015)
 - Front Lobby remodel
 - Offices, training room, and team room upgrades
- Phase 3 (**pending funding**)
 - Locker room – private space for the teams
 - Infrastructure – outdoor lighting, PA system, and wireless
 - Indoor and outdoor signage – logos, banners, etc
 - Spectator shade structure

Total Project Cost Estimated at \$1.2M
