




104 - Bullseye - Shooting the Perfect X-Ray

Digital radiography has some tremendous advantages over traditional film, no more chemicals, instant feedback, amazing images ... well...maybe not so much. The technology is amazing. The images could be amazing. However, many dental practices have grown accustomed to poor diagnostic quality images.

They seem to be resigned to foreshortening, cone cuts and closed contacts. There are even a few who just accept mandibular molar images without apices as if that's as good as it gets. What's up with that?!? Let's face it, there are significant differences between wired digital sensors and film. Identifying them is half the battle, overcoming them is the other.
