NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons in Fannin and Grayson Counties, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Red River Groundwater Conservation District ("District") will hold a public meeting, accept public comment, and consider the proposed Desired Future Conditions for the groundwater resources within the District pursuant to Section 36.108(d-2) of the Texas Water Code. The proposed Desired Future Conditions for the District are as follows: District-wide average aquifer drawdown through 2080 of (in feet by aquifer/layer): 209 in Woodbine; 830 in Paluxy; 335 in Glen Rose; 405 in Twin Mountain; 291 in Travis Peak; 321 in Antlers. County-wide average aquifer drawdown through 2080 of (in feet by aquifer/layer): Fannin – 259 in Woodbine, 709 in Paluxy, 305 in Glen Rose, 400 in Twin Mountain, 291 in Travis Peak; 269 in Antlers; Grayson – 163 in Woodbine, 943 in Paluxy, 364 in Glen Rose, 445 in Twin Mountain, 364 in Antlers.

The District developed the proposed Desired Future Conditions as required by Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code with the other groundwater conservation districts in Groundwater Management Area 8. The other districts within Groundwater Management Area 8 include: Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District; Clearwater Underground Water Conservation District; Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District; Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District; North Texas Groundwater Conservation District; Saratoga Underground Water Conservation District; Southern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; and Upper Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.

The public meeting will be held on Thursday, January 21, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. at the District Office located at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, TX 75020. Comments on the proposed Desired Future Conditions may be presented in written or verbal form at the meeting. Written comments may also be submitted prior to the meeting by email at rrgcd@redrivergcd.org, or by mail or hand-delivery at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, TX 75020.

The District Board of Directors will also hold a permit hearing and regular Board meeting at the same time and place as the public meeting on the proposed Desired Future Conditions. Agenda items for the permit hearing and regular Board meeting include: Production Permit Hearing, pledge of allegiance and invocation, call to order, public comment, approval of minutes, approval of invoices and reimbursements, budget and finance report, update and possible action on the process for development of Desired Future Conditions, compliance and enforcement activities, General Manager's report (update on operational, educational, and other activities), discussion of new business for future meeting agendas, and adjourn meeting.
