Manager's Report: May 2020, Dennis Strand

COVID 19 Developments

As you may be aware the Governor has announced PHASE I of his plan to reopen the State of North Carolina. It will take effect on Friday, May 8, 2020 and

will affect the residents of the Bear Paw community (BPSD, Cottages, Condominiums) as follows:

- Safe Distancing (at least 6 feet) continues
- Gathering in groups of less than 10 must continue
- The Clubhouse will remain closed other than during the time the Office is staffed with access only through the main pavilion door

As far as use of BPSD amenities, the Children's Playground, Tennis and Basketball Courts and Volleyball area WILL REMAIN CLOSED. The BPSD Pool, regulated by Cherokee County, will also remain CLOSED.

Phase II will take affect 2-3 weeks from May 8, 2020 and is expected to address additional openings of commercial establishments, recreational facility's, and places of worship but with increased group size allowances.

Phase II will take affect 6-8 weeks after Phase II and is expected to outline overall opening of the State.

If you have any questions or desire additional information do not hesitate to call me. Thank you.

Pool The pool continues to be closed for the season. No tentative date(s) for County inspections are being established due to Corvid-19. Given future developments the pool may have an abbreviated open season or may not be open dependent upon the County and continued Corvid 19 restrictions.

<u>New Home Construction</u> One new home currently under construction. on Highland. One new construction due to Corvid 19 issues.

<u>Other Construction / Zoning</u> A deck replacement and extension, siding, and renovation projects (2) approved over the past 3 months.

Security No changes or concerns nut a special thank you to JC, Kevin, and Dorothy for their handling of some difficult incidents/situations over the winter months. Due to a problem with the heating unit in the guard house in late Winter a replacement was done during the Winter.

Trees

Guards continue to require all commercial tree cutters entering BPSD report to the Office prior to going to the property to assure their knowledge of BPSD restrictions as well as to check on approval having been given to the homeowner(s). Homeowners are reminded that any tree other than a pine requires approval from my office prior to cutting.

Clubhouse

Replacement of the new HVAC system in the early Fall has resulted in very significant reduction is our monthly heating costs. Continued reductions are anticipated with our upcoming AC costs.

<u>Roads</u> A Culvert cleaning will be undertaken in May-June. White striping will be done in **MAY**.

Tennis Court

A new bench is expected in May-June

Playground

Additional piece of equipment (Discovery Backyard multi-unit) to be erected in mid-late MAY or early JUNE.

<u>Other</u> Due to weather issues landscaping and floral/shrub planting began in the past week and is expected to be complete by early to mid-May.
