DRESS CODE

We want to remind everyone that it is important to come to class <u>dressed appropriately</u>.

This allows students to **move comfortably**, instructors are able to see their **body alignment**, and it establishes <u>responsibility</u>, <u>discipline and confidence</u> in their dance instruction. Hair MUST BE pulled up in a bun or ponytail for every class. Short hair may be pulled half up, half down.

PLEASE DO NOT WEAR STREET CLOTHES:

NO dresses, skirts, or jeans. NO Crocs or Sandals. Please make sure all undergarments are covered.

BALLET -Leotard, tights, ballet shoes, hair in a BUN

ACRO - Athletic attire: dance leggings or dance shorts, fitted dance tops, barefoot, hair in a bun or ponytail

TAP - Dance leggings or dance shorts, fitted dance tops, tap shoes, hair in a bun or ponytail

CHEER / TUMBLING / STUNT - Athletic attire: cheer shorts or dance leggings, fitted dance tops, **lightweight tennis shoes WITH laces** (no vans, converse or slip-ons), hair in a ponytail Recommended cheer shoes: https://www.omnicheer.com/Search?q=shoes

HIP HOP - Sweats or leggings, a t-shirt or crop top, hair in a ponytail, sneakers
