SECTION VII penalties and liabilities

"Any person who violates a provision of this Ordinance shall be liable for penalty as follow:

NON INJURY \$50.00 (not more than \$2000.00 at Court discretion)

INJURY , DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGES

Cite for \$50.00 and have victim provide documentation for costs incurred, final judgement to be determined by Court
