The top KYC finisher was George Welch Jr. in **Mojo** in 12th place with a second in the first race. Anders Hudson in **Sugaree** was awarded Top Vintage Boat in 17th place overall, and Matt Newman in **Betty** was Top Rookie in 18th place overall.

The wind conditions were challenging varying from next to nothing to an incoming squall that saw the fleet turn and head back to the dock. Four races were completed on Friday, none on Saturday, and two on Sunday. Race 5 had only 4 competitors cross the finish line within the time limit with all other competitors scoring a 5/TLE—a definite downer for the few that were nearly there, but a relief to those caught in the doldrums at the far end of the course.
