TROUT NEWS

Summer seems as though it just began and now, fall is upon us—which means it's Trout Time. The time has come to prepare the nursery for the new batch of trout fingerlings arriving mid-October.

Our initial Trout Nursery Clean-up is scheduled for Saturday, October 9 at 9:00am. Jerry Lauer and I are working on the details for cleaning the filter box and fish pen.

LAKE TONIAN

The pond is finally back at full pool, actually flowing quite well out the overflow. If you watch the shoreline close enough, you will be able to see groups of fingerling bluegill, small fathead minnows, and the occasional crappie fingerling. This situation has not been happening for years, and a very good sign of the pond responding to our management efforts.

We will continue to encourage removing ALL largemouth bass under 13". All bluegill, crappie, and largemouth bass 13" and over must be released, unharmed, back into the pond.

There has been a turtle trap placed along the north shoreline. This can be seen as a square structure of white tubing. Until we can get the painted turtle population under control, this live trap will be a permanent structure throughout the spring and summer months.

Fall is quickly closing in, which means the fishing will get much easier and your chances of catching that trophy fish is greatly increased. Enjoy your time at the pond! -Zig (717-578-1718) zigsjigs@comcast.net
