The Competitive Edge Agility & Dog Sports will be available to exhibitors Monday, October 5, 2015 at 7:00 pm. Dogs should be removed from the Competitive Edge Agility & Dog Sports as soon as possible following judging on Tuesday, October 6, 2015.

- Crating & grooming will be allowed in designated areas only. Cleanup of the grooming areas will be the owner's responsibility & will be policed daily. Dogs may **NOT** be left overnight in the grooming areas.
- Neither the show-giving club nor the host sites will be responsible for the safety or well being of dogs or other property left at the sites.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining clean conditions around their grooming area. Exhibitors should bring their own cleaning supplies.
- After loading & unloading, vehicles must be moved to the parking area. No parking is allowed immediately adjoining the loading & unloading area.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Show Secretary is not able to cash checks.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and at least of two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - The Brace Class shall be for two dogs of at least one identical owner or co-owner regardless of sex. The two dogs comprising the Brace shall be considered a unit and they must be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace is not entered in a regular class, or Best of Breed Competition, the dog must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for Brace Class Only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a brace, MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for ADDITIONAL CLASSES - "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

MOONLIGHT WORLD CHAMPION CHALLENGE

ENTRIES TAKEN UNTIL 1 HOUR BEFORE THE EVENT STARTS

This year's judges will be announced on October 5th. Entries will be taken September 29-October 2, 2015. Please contact Carrie Huddleston, Courtney Morris or Stephanie Rogers for an entry form.

A copy of the Championship Certificate must be provided for verification of the title at the time of entry.

The STCA's Moonlight World Champion Challenge is not held under the auspices of the AKC. The World Challenge is open to AKC, CKC & FCI Champions of Record. Dogs entered in this competition must be eligible to compete in AKC/CKC/FCI shows, & must not be spayed or neutered. Judging shall be based on overall soundness, quality of movement & type as defined in the breed standard. Ideally judges chosen for Tournament shall be a breeder, a professional handler, & a licensed or provisional judge.

Entry fee - \$35.00

1. All dogs (males first) enter the ring in numerical order & are checked in.
2. The first three dogs are kept in the ring for judging & the remaining dogs will be released to a holding area.
3. The judges will be in three corners of the ring for the hands on examination. The dogs will move counter-clockwise until all three judges have examined all three dogs. Judging shall be limited to approximately three minutes per dog. Score the sheet after each individual exam.
4. When the last dog of the set has been examined, judges will assemble in one corner of the ring & the dogs will be moved individually on a diagonal down & back, then around to the end. Finally as a group, they will be moved once around the ring & then exit.
5. Final scoring of the group is completed & score sheets are handed in & the second group of three dogs enter the ring. This continues until all male entries have been examined.
6. All females enter the ring & repeat steps 2 through 5.
7. Once every dog has been examined, there will be a short break while the scores are tallied. The top 8 highest scoring dogs (of either sex) will be called back to the ring for further judging. If there is a tie for the 8th placement, additional dogs will be called back in.
8. Judges are handed new score sheets & may re-evaluate the top scoring dogs. Judges may re-examine each dog in brief, if necessary. Once the final examination is complete, each dog is moved individually, down & back & around to the exit.
9. The score sheets are turned in for final tabulation. The second score of each from the "top 8" will be averaged with the first score. Any resulting tied scores will stand as is for placements.
10. The score will be calculated (during this time, we will do a performance demonstration).
11. The top 4 dogs will be called back into the ring & the winners will be announced.
