Congratulations Ms. Katie Rietschlin!

I am honored to share that Katie Rietschlin, our 5th and 6th grade teacher at Sacred Heart School, was nominated and has received the Golden Apple Award through the Diocese of Toledo. The Golden Apple Award was established to honor outstanding individuals who devote their lives to teaching at Catholic schools. This award is given to seven preschool and/or elementary school teachers and two secondary teachers each year throughout the Diocese of Toledo.

There are strict requirements that the candidate must meet. They must be a practicing Catholic, fulltime teacher with a minimum of 3 years experience in the school at which they are currently teaching, nominated by a teacher, student or parent and hold a valid license or certification to fulfill both diocesan and state requirements.

Once a teacher is nominated they must write an essay about their ministry at their school, the principal and pastor must write letters of recommendations about the nominated teacher. There is a committee at the Diocese that select from all of the teachers that were nominated. This is some very strict competition. Please understand that the Golden Apple Award is only awarded to a small percentage of teachers that are nominated.

We are truly blessed to have Ms. Rietschlin minister at Sacred Heart School. She is an outstanding role model for our students academically and spiritually. Please help me congratulate her in this outstanding achievement!
