DESCRIPTION: Here is a high-end Shakespeare X-15 tournament target and field bow. Great looking and performing Bubinga recurve in excellent condition. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or general stress lines in the limbs. There is a 1/2" stress line crack in the fiberglass between the grip and the sight window (see pic on p. 4). A few scratches and scuffs and blemishes. This is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. Note: There is some glare from the photos that make the riser appear to have "splotches". It is just the glare from the camera shot.
