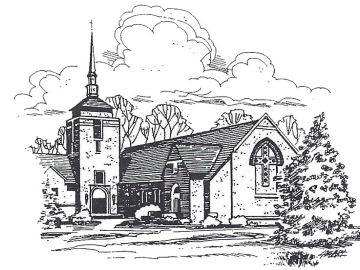

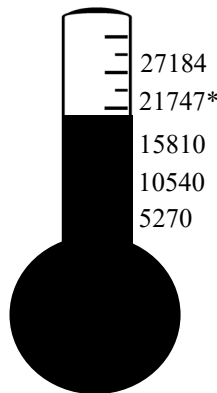
Next Sunday:
