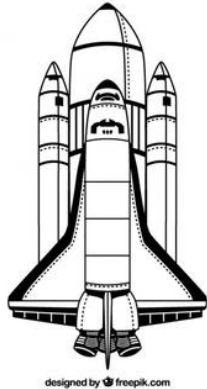

PEA SALAD

Beverly's Christmas Luncheon Recipe

1 (15 oz) package of frozen peas green
1 cup of dry roasted salted peanuts
1 cup dried sweetened cranberries
1/2 cup cooked bacon pieces
1/3 cup Vidalia onion chopped
1/4 cup pre-sliced green onions
1/4 teaspoon Kosher salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Dressing

1/2 cup mayo
1 1/2 tablespoon vinegar
1 teaspoon sugar
1/4 teaspoon soy sauce
1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
salt and pepper to taste
Mix all ingredients together



Cook peas 2 minutes or until thawed. Put peas into a bowl and add peanuts, cranberries, bacon bits, Vidalia onion, green onions, salt, and pepper.
Add dressing and mix well. Chill in refrigerator. Serves 6 I usually use less salt for a lower salt intake
Enjoy.....this recipe is a combination of several recipes.

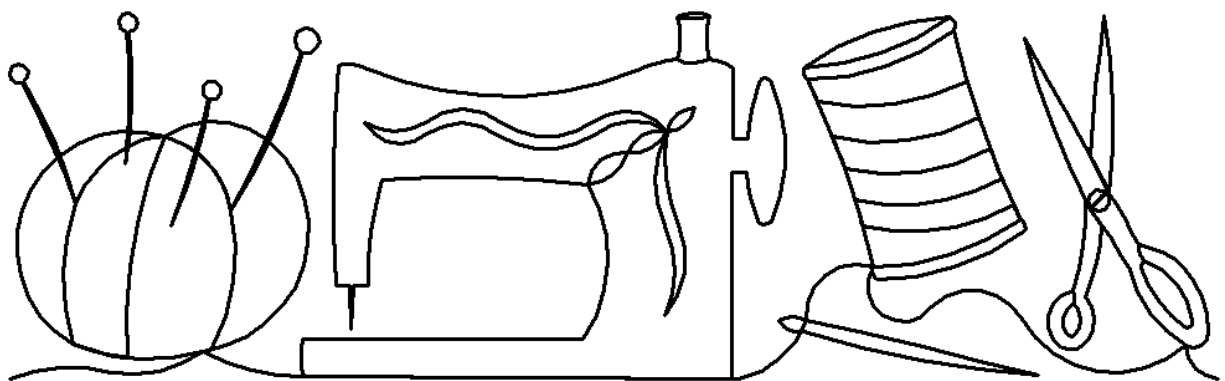
March Guild Meeting Speaker – Cecilia Reid

Pat Reid Baby Quilt contest

Contest will be judged at the April Guild Meeting by Cecilia Reid. Quilts with application need to be turned in the week before judging.

Quilt Requirements –

- *Must be a scrappy quilt. All techniques accepted: pieced, appliqued, embroidery.
- *The finished should be no smaller than 36"x36" and no larger than 40"x54"
- *Members may enter as many completed quilts as they desire
- *The Guild will not provide any fabric and/or supplies for the quilt
- *Quilt must be received by the deadline, or it will not be eligible to be judged
