PROTEST VOTE FAILS, TRANSITION OF CAYUCOS FIRE TO COUNTY CONTINUES –

The San Luis Obispo County (SLOC) Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will meet a **9 am on Thursday, October 18** in the Supervisors Chambers at the SLOC Government Center (1055 Monterey). First up on the Consent Agenda is the result of the protest vote regarding the dissolution of the Cayucos Fire Protection District and transfer of Fire/Emergency services to the County. There were 390 protest votes cast, falling well short of the 25 percent necessary to send the proposal to a vote of registered voters in Cayucos. As a result, LAFCO will move forward with the next steps in the transfer of Cayucos Fire District responsibilities to County Fire. The agenda also includes [A-2] a report on the First Quarter Budget status for LAFCO, and [B-1] the annexation of the Luis Ranch to the City SLO.
