

# Tualatin Elementary Read-A-Thon 2019



## Read-A-Thon Rules

- Assigned reading for homework and book report counts.
- You can read independently or other people can read to you. Reading aloud to other people counts. If you read to your friend or sibling it counts for both of you!
- You can only read a book once for the contest. When you finish the book, read another!
- Please use a timer and no guessing or rounding of minutes.
- Reading for the event is from **Feb15-Feb22**.
- Parents need to initial the Reading Minutes Recording sheet to confirm the logged minutes to ensure fairness.

## How it works

- Students set a reading goal.
- Students read during the designated days and keep track of their minutes every day.
- Students get pledges from family, friends, neighbors and business.
- Students use Sponsorship form to track sponsors and how much money they pledged to donate.
- Students return the envelope with the Reading log/pledge form and funds collected to the teacher.
- Prizes are awarded to all participants and winners.

***All students are encouraged to participate in this event whether they raise money or not. Each student receives a participation prize and can use their reading minutes to earn individual or classroom prizes!***

### (2) Top reading minutes (1,000 minutes or more):

Student who reads 1,000 minutes or more will receive a gift card to Barnes and Noble.

### (3) Top pledge amount:

Every student who raises the most money in each grade level will earn "Pizza with the Principal" lunch.

### (4) Participation Prize:

All students who return their envelope with the reading log completed will receive a pencil and bookmark. All participants who meet their reading goal will be entered into a drawing for a chance to win a book from the 2019 OBOB booklist.
