Romans 12

As your shepherd, I see God revealing Himself to us as we begin to dream and wonder how we will be transformed in 2019. The will of God IS perfect! Paul uses the word, $\mu \hat{\epsilon} \lambda o \zeta$, which is translated here as "member." Since "member" might suggest, "independence, wholeness" I would rather use the "limb" because we are dependent on one another in the body of Christ. *4For as in one body we have many limbs, and not all the limbs have the same function.* Mt Hermon needs **your limb**! We need to hear your dreams and your visions. We need to depend on each other for gifts, ministry, teaching, and generosity.


